

SENATE BILL No. 567

June 7, 2005, Introduced by Senator GEORGE and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1972 PA 106, entitled
"Highway advertising act of 1972,"
(MCL 252.301 to 252.325) by adding section 7a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 7A. FROM THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT
2 ADDED THIS SECTION UNTIL DECEMBER 31, 2008, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
3 NOT ISSUE A PERMIT FOR A SIGN UNLESS THE APPLICANT SURRENDERS A
4 PREVIOUSLY ISSUED PERMIT. EXCEPT FOR ANY SIGN REMOVED IN ACCORDANCE
5 WITH SECTION 19, IF A SIGN FOR WHICH A PERMIT HAS BEEN ISSUED IS
6 REMOVED FOR ANY REASON, THE PERMIT HOLDER MAY NOTIFY THE DEPARTMENT
7 OF THE SIGN'S REMOVAL AND EXCHANGE THE PERMIT FOR THE REMOVED SIGN
8 FOR AN INTERIM PERMIT WITH NO DESIGNATED SIGN LOCATION. AN INTERIM
9 PERMIT SHALL BE SURRENDERED WITH AN APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT FOR A
10 SIGN.

11 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect

2 of the 93rd Legislature is enacted into law.
