- 1 SEC. 7A. FROM THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT
- 2 ADDED THIS SECTION UNTIL DECEMBER 31, 2008, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
- 3 NOT ISSUE A PERMIT FOR A SIGN UNLESS THE APPLICANT SURRENDERS A
- 4 PREVIOUSLY ISSUED PERMIT. EXCEPT FOR ANY SIGN REMOVED IN ACCORDANCE
- 5 WITH SECTION 19, IF A SIGN FOR WHICH A PERMIT HAS BEEN ISSUED IS
- REMOVED FOR ANY REASON, THE PERMIT HOLDER MAY NOTIFY THE DEPARTMENT
- OF THE SIGN'S REMOVAL AND EXCHANGE THE PERMIT FOR THE REMOVED SIGN
- 8 FOR AN INTERIM PERMIT WITH NO DESIGNATED SIGN LOCATION. AN INTERIM
- 9 PERMIT SHALL BE SURRENDERED WITH AN APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT FOR A
- 10 SIGN.
