THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 2229. (1) IF AN INSURER REFUSES TO PAY AN INSURED FOR
- 2 LOSS OR DAMAGE INCURRED AND COVERED UNDER AN AUTOMOBILE OR HOME
- 3 INSURANCE POLICY BECAUSE THE INSURER SUSPECTS THE INSURED WAS
- 4 INVOLVED IN ARSON OR THEFT CONCERNING THE LOSS OR DAMAGE, THE
- 5 INSURER SHALL NOTIFY THE FIRE OR LAW ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITY WITH
- 6 JURISDICTION IN THE LOCALE WHERE THE LOSS OR DAMAGE OCCURRED OF THE
- 7 INSURER'S SUSPICIONS.
- 8 (2) IF AN INSURED PREVAILS AFTER TRIAL IN AN ACTION TO RECOVER
 - UNDER AN INSURANCE POLICY WHERE THE INSURER HAD REFUSED TO PAY
