- 1 conservation officers; —, and AN OFFICER OF THE motor carrier
- 2 inspectors of the Michigan public service commission ENFORCEMENT
- 3 DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE, "personal injury"
- 4 shall be construed to include INCLUDES respiratory and heart
- 5 diseases or illnesses resulting therefrom -which THAT develop or
- 6 manifest themselves during a period while the member of the
