A bill to amend 1956 PA 218, entitled "The insurance code of 1956,"

(MCL 500.100 to 500.8302) by adding section 2117a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 2117A. A HOME INSURANCE POLICY SHALL NOT EXCLUDE FROM
- 2 COVERAGE ANY CLAIM RESULTING FROM AN ACT COMMITTED BY AN INSURED IN
- 3 SELF-DEFENSE. SELF-DEFENSE SHALL BE AN EXCEPTION TO ANY INTENTIONAL
- 4 ACTS EXCLUSION IN A HOME INSURANCE POLICY AND AN INJURY RESULTING
- 5 FROM AN ACT COMMITTED BY AN INSURED IN SELF-DEFENSE SHALL NOT BE
- 6 CONSIDERED AN EXPECTED OR INTENDED ACT.
