- 18 INDIVIDUAL AND IN THE CAPACITY OF A QUALIFYING OFFICER, OR WHO IS
- 19 LICENSED AS A QUALIFYING OFFICER MORE THAN ONCE, IS ONLY OBLIGATED
- 20 TO PAY THE CODE BOOK FEE ONCE PER LICENSE CYCLE.
