June 30, 2005, Introduced by Senators BROWN, VAN WOERKOM, BIRKHOLZ, GILBERT, PATTERSON, CROPSEY, KUIPERS, BISHOP, HARDIMAN and GEORGE and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources and Environmental Affairs.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," (MCL 324.101 to 324.90106) by adding part 175.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 PART 175. "RECYCLING WORKS" FUND
- 2 SEC. 17501. AS USED IN THIS PART:
- 3 (A) "DEPARTMENT" MEANS THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL
- 4 QUALITY.
- 5 (B) "FUND" MEANS THE "RECYCLING WORKS" FUND CREATED IN SECTION
- 6 17503.
- 7 SEC. 17503. (1) THE "RECYCLING WORKS" FUND IS CREATED WITHIN
- 8 THE STATE TREASURY.
- (2) THE STATE TREASURER MAY RECEIVE FOR DEPOSIT INTO THE FUND
 - MONEY APPROPRIATED FOR THIS PURPOSE UNDER SECTION 437 OF THE INCOME

- 1 TAX ACT OF 1967, 1967 PA 281, MCL 206.437, AND MONEY OR OTHER
- 2 ASSETS FROM CONTRIBUTIONS FROM ANY SOURCE. THE STATE TREASURER
- 3 SHALL DIRECT THE INVESTMENT OF THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL
- 4 CREDIT TO THE FUND INTEREST AND EARNINGS FROM FUND INVESTMENTS.
- 5 (3) MONEY IN THE FUND AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR SHALL
- 6 REMAIN IN THE FUND AND SHALL NOT LAPSE TO THE GENERAL FUND.
- 7 (4) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL EXPEND MONEY FROM THE FUND, UPON
- 8 APPROPRIATION, ONLY TO FUND STATEWIDE RECYCLING PROGRAMS.
