## **SENATE BILL No. 712**

August 31, 2005, Introduced by Senator BROWN and referred to the Committee on Senior Citizens and Veterans Affairs.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

by amending section 303a (MCL 750.303a), as added by 1996 PA 539.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 303a. This chapter does not apply to recreational card
- 2 playing conducted at a senior citizen housing facility OR A SENIOR
- 3 CENTER THAT IS NOT A HOUSING FACILITY IF ALL OF THE FOLLOWING
- 4 APPLY:
  - (A) THE FACILITY OR CENTER IS not licensed by the liquor control commission.
  - (B) THE CARD PLAYING IS CONDUCTED by a senior citizens club or a group of residents of —a— THE senior citizen housing facility
  - that consists of at least 15 members who are 60 years of age or
