SENATE BILL No. 841

October 25, 2005, Introduced by Senator STAMAS and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1980 PA 299, entitled "Occupational code,"

by amending sections 1301, 1302, 1304, 1305, 1307, and 1308 (MCL 339.1301, 339.1302, 339.1304, 339.1305, 339.1307, and 339.1308), sections 1301, 1305, and 1307 as amended by 1988 PA 463, and by adding section 1303a; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 1301. As used in this article:

- (a) "Hearing aid" means an instrument or device designed for regular and constant use in or proximate to the human ear and represented as aiding or improving defective human hearing.
- (b) "Hearing aid dealer" means an individual who engages in the sale or offering for sale at retail of a hearing aid.

- 1 (B) -(c) "Hearing -aid salesperson" HEALTH CARE ASSISTANT"
- 2 means an individual who engages in the sale or offering for sale at
- 3 retail of a hearing aid and who is -an- A DIRECT employee of a
- 4 hearing -aid dealer HEALTH CARE PROVIDER.
- 5 (C) "HEARING HEALTH CARE PROVIDER" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO
- 6 ENGAGES IN THE SALE OR OFFERING FOR SALE AT RETAIL OF A HEARING
- 7 AID.
- 8 (d) "Practice of selling or fitting a hearing aid" means the
- 9 selection, adaptation, DISPENSING, and sale of a hearing aid and
- 10 includes the testing of hearing by means of an audiometer and other
- 11 means for the sale of a hearing aid. The practice also includes the
- 12 making of an impression for an ear mold.
- (e) "Unethical conduct" means ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 14 (i) Selling a hearing aid intended to be used by an individual
- 15 16 years of age or less without an otologic examination and
- 16 approval by a physician and an audiologic evaluation and
- 17 recommendation.
- 18 (ii) Canvassing from house to house or place of business either
- 19 in person or by an agent for selling a hearing aid without prior
- 20 referral or request.
- 21 (iii) Failing to properly and reasonably accept responsibility
- 22 for the actions of a licensed trainee.
- 23 (iv) Offering, paying, causing to be paid, or inferring that a
- 24 payment might be made, directly or indirectly, of money or other
- 25 thing of value to an audiologist, otologist, physician, clinic, or
- 26 other similar medical person or institution as a consideration for
- 27 a referral by a medical person or institution or as a part of an

- 1 agreement with a medical person or institution.
- 2 Sec. 1302. This article -shall DOES not prohibit a person
- 3 from engaging in the business of selling or offering for sale a
- 4 hearing aid at retail without a license, if the person employs only
- 5 licensed hearing -aid dealers and salespersons HEALTH CARE
- 6 PROVIDERS AND HEARING HEALTH CARE ASSISTANTS in the direct sale and
- 7 fitting of the -product HEARING AID. Each person shall file
- 8 annually with the department a list of each licensed hearing -aid
- 9 dealer or salesperson HEALTH CARE PROVIDER OR HEARING HEALTH CARE
- 10 ASSISTANT directly or indirectly employed by the person and a
- 11 statement on a form approved by the department that the person will
- 12 submit to COMPLY WITH the rules promulgated under this article and
- 13 the APPLICABLE provisions of this article. which the department
- 14 considers applicable. A person engaging in the business of selling
- 15 or offering for sale a hearing aid at retail shall maintain a place
- 16 of business in this state <u>which</u> THAT is an actual, established
- 17 physical location from which the person conducts business and where
- 18 each applicable book or record is maintained. A branch office of
- 19 the person shall be under the personal direct supervision of a
- 20 hearing -aid dealer HEALTH CARE PROVIDER or hearing -aid
- 21 salesperson HEALTH CARE ASSISTANT as qualified in section 1305.
- 22 SEC. 1303A. (1) THE BOARD OF HEARING HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS IS
- 23 CREATED. SIX MEMBERS OF THE BOARD SHALL BE QUALIFIED HEARING HEALTH
- 24 CARE PROVIDERS WHO HAVE BEEN ACTIVELY ENGAGED IN THE SALE OF
- 25 HEARING AIDS FOR AT LEAST 3 YEARS.
- 26 (2) NOT MORE THAN 2 MEMBERS OF THE BOARD SHALL BE EMPLOYEES
- 27 OF, FRANCHISED BY, OR ASSOCIATED EXCLUSIVELY WITH THE SAME HEARING

- 1 AID MANUFACTURER.
- 2 Sec. 1304. (1) The department shall issue a license as a
- 3 hearing aid dealer **HEALTH CARE PROVIDER** or salesperson **HEARING**
- 4 HEALTH CARE ASSISTANT to each person INDIVIDUAL it finds
- 5 qualified under this article.
- 6 (2) Upon the request of a person, the department shall furnish
- 7 a list of licensed hearing -aid dealers HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS.
- 8 Sec. 1305. (1) An individual -wishing to sell or fit DESIRING
- 9 TO ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF SELLING, FITTING, OR DISPENSING a
- 10 hearing aid in connection with the sale of a hearing aid as a
- 11 dealer HEARING HEALTH CARE PROVIDER shall -make application APPLY
- 12 to the department. An individual employed by a -dealer HEARING
- 13 HEALTH CARE PROVIDER as a hearing -aid salesperson HEALTH CARE
- 14 ASSISTANT shall -make application APPLY to the department.
- 15 (2) An THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE A LICENSE TO AN applicant
- 16 for a license as a hearing -aid dealer shall be issued a license
- 17 HEALTH CARE PROVIDER if the applicant is over 18 years of age, is
- 18 of good moral character, is a graduate of an accredited high school
- 19 or secondary school, has served as a licensed hearing aid
- 20 salesperson OR HEALTH CARE ASSISTANT for a period of 2 years under
- 21 the <u>-direction</u> **DIRECT EMPLOYMENT** and supervision of a licensed
- 22 hearing aid dealer OR HEALTH CARE PROVIDER, and passes a written
- 23 AND PRACTICAL examination as prescribed by the department and the
- 24 board.
- 25 (3) —An— THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE TO AN applicant —for— a
- 26 license as a hearing aid salesperson shall be issued a license
- 27 HEALTH CARE ASSISTANT if the applicant is at least 18 years of age,

- 1 is of good moral character, is a graduate from an accredited high
- 2 school or secondary school, successfully completes additional
- 3 training and education as may be required by the department, passes
- 4 a written AND PRACTICAL examination as prescribed by the department
- 5 and the board, and has served at least 6 months as a trainee
- 6 licensed by the department.
- 7 (4) The department and the board shall encourage the
- 8 establishment of a specialized educational course of training for
- 9 an individual wishing to become a licensed hearing -aid dealer
- 10 HEALTH CARE PROVIDER or hearing -aid salesperson- HEALTH CARE
- 11 ASSISTANT.
- 12 (5) In place of the written examination provided in subsection
- 13 (2), the department may accept successful completion of the basic
- 14 home study course, AS APPROVED BY THE BOARD, conducted by the
- 15 national INTERNATIONAL hearing -aid society or may waive the
- 16 examination provided for in subsection (2) when proof satisfactory
- 17 to the department and the board is submitted showing that the
- 18 applicant has successfully passed an examination given by the
- 19 official hearing aid examining board in another state, if the
- 20 examination and passing requirements at the time taken, were
- 21 substantially equal to those required by the department.
- 22 Sec. 1307. (1) The department may grant a trainee license to
- 23 an applicant working for and under the direct supervision of a
- 24 licensed -dealer HEARING HEALTH CARE PROVIDER on the following
- 25 conditions:
- 26 (a) The trainee license shall be IS valid for a 12-month
- 27 period AND MAY BE RENEWED FOR UP TO 3 YEARS. A new trainee license

- 1 may be issued by the board DEPARTMENT upon the filing of an
- 2 application.
- 3 (b) The trainee license -shall provide PROVIDES that the
- 4 individual to whom it was issued shall work for and under the
- 5 direction DIRECT EMPLOYMENT and supervision of a named licensed
- 6 hearing <u>aid dealer</u> **HEALTH CARE PROVIDER**.
- 7 (2) The department may transfer a license of a trainee upon
- 8 the filing of an application BY THE TRAINEE for a transfer.
- 9 (3) A trainee license is subject to revocation for the same
- 10 reasons and in a similar manner as a regular license.
- 11 Sec. 1308. The written examination provided for in section
- 12 1305 shall test the applicant's knowledge and shall be a practical
- 13 demonstration of the -potential seller's APPLICANT'S ability in
- 14 giving a basic audiometric test, in taking an ear mold impression,
- 15 and in following the prescribed rules in fitting and referral for
- 16 otologic examination.
- 17 Enacting section 1. Section 1303 of the occupational code,
- 18 1980 PA 299, MCL 339.1303, is repealed.
