- 3 IMPOSED BY THIS ACT EQUAL TO THE AMOUNT THE TAXPAYER PAID IN THE
- 4 TAX YEAR FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF A SECURITY SYSTEM OR
- 5 SECURITY MEASURES THAT COMPLY WITH THE ANHYDROUS AMMONIA SAFETY AND
- 6 SECURITY PRACTICES ESTABLISHED BY THE COMMISSION ON AGRICULTURE
- 7 THAT PREVENT THE THEFT OF ANHYDROUS AMMONIA IF THE TAXPAYER IS AN
- 8 END USER OF THE ANHYDROUS AMMONIA.
