## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 105. (1) The -state department shall establish a program

- for medical assistance for the medically indigent under title XIX.

  The director of the <u>state</u> department shall administer the program established by the <u>state</u> department and <u>shall be</u> IS responsible for determining eligibility under this act. Except as otherwise provided in this act, the director may delegate the authority to perform a function necessary or appropriate for the proper administration of the program.
  - (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REDETERMINE ELIGIBILITY FOR INDIVIDUALS ENROLLED IN ANY MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR THE
