A bill to amend 1990 PA 187, entitled "The pupil transportation act," by amending section 39 (MCL 257.1839).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 39. (1) The BEGINNING JULY 1, 2006, THE department of
- 2 state police -shall MAY, UPON REQUEST OF A PERSON HAVING CONTROL
- 3 OVER THE OPERATION OF A SCHOOL BUS OR PUPIL TRANSPORTATION VEHICLE,
- 4 inspect each school bus and pupil transportation vehicle annually,
- 5 and more frequently at a school where school bus or pupil
- 6 transportation vehicle defects have been found AND IF REQUESTED, to
- determine if the school bus or pupil transportation vehicle meets
- B the requirements of this act and the rules promulgated pursuant to

- 1 inspection of school buses to publicly employed inspectors if the
- 2 inspection complies with this section.
- 3 (2) Inspection of a school bus or pupil transportation vehicle
- 4 may be accomplished at any time, at any location, on or off a
- 5 school site, and as frequently as the department of state police
- 6 considers necessary to secure passenger safety REQUESTED UNDER
- 7 THIS SECTION. A school bus or pupil transportation vehicle may be

- 21 (4) A modified school bus which uses liquefied petroleum gas
- 22 shall not be used to transport pupils unless the installation of
- 23 the fuel system has been inspected and approved as safe by the
