- 3 OF A CRIME AT THE TIME HE OR SHE USED THAT FORCE, IS IMMUNE FROM
- 4 CIVIL LIABILITY FOR THE USE OF THAT FORCE. THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT
- 5 GRANT IMMUNITY FOR DAMAGES CAUSED TO AN INDIVIDUAL OTHER THAN THE
- 6 INDIVIDUAL AGAINST WHOM THE USE OF FORCE IS AUTHORIZED UNDER THE
- 7 SELF-DEFENSE ACT.
- (2) THE COURT SHALL, UNDER THIS SECTION, AWARD THE PAYMENT OF
