SENATE BILL No. 1195

March 28, 2006, Introduced by Senators BROWN, SWITALSKI, PATTERSON, GOSCHKA, JOHNSON, CASSIS, OLSHOVE and BIRKHOLZ and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 811e (MCL 257.811e), as amended by 2001 PA 124, and by adding section 811m; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 811e. (1) The secretary of state may develop a Michigan university fund-raising registration plate as described in this section, and a matching Michigan university collector plate as described in section 811g.

- (2) The secretary of state may develop 1 or more limited term registration plates to recognize a state-sponsored event, a Michigan university, or an accomplishment or occasion of a Michigan university.
 - (3) The secretary of state may -, at any 1 time, develop not

- 2 SECTION 811E AND MAY ISSUE UNDER SECTION 811F A STATE-SPONSORED
