April 25, 2006, Introduced by Senators TOY and GILBERT and referred to the Committee on Senior Citizens and Veterans Affairs.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

by amending section 168 (MCL 750.168) and by adding section 167d.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 167D. (1) A PERSON SHALL NOT DO ANY OF THE FOLLOWING
- 2 WITHIN 500 FEET OF A BUILDING OR OTHER LOCATION WHERE A FUNERAL,
- 3 MEMORIAL SERVICE, OR VIEWING OF A DECEASED PERSON IS BEING
- 4 CONDUCTED OR WITHIN 500 FEET OF A FUNERAL PROCESSION OR BURIAL:
- 5 (A) MAKE LOUD AND RAUCOUS NOISE AND CONTINUE TO DO SO AFTER 6 BEING ASKED TO STOP.
- 7 (B) MAKE ANY STATEMENT OR GESTURE THAT WOULD MAKE A REASONABLE
- 8 PERSON UNDER THE CIRCUMSTANCES FEEL INTIMIDATED, THREATENED, OR
- 9 HARASSED.
 - (C) ENGAGE IN ANY OTHER CONDUCT THAT THE PERSON KNOWS OR
