## **SENATE BILL No. 1257**

May 9, 2006, Introduced by Senators SANBORN and KUIPERS and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 716 (MCL 257.716), as amended by 1998 PA 427.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 716. (1) Unless specifically declared to be a civil
- 2 infraction, it is a misdemeanor for a person to drive or move or
- 3 for the owner to cause or permit to be driven or moved on a highway
- 4 a vehicle or vehicles of a size or weight exceeding the limitations
- 5 stated in this chapter or otherwise in violation of this chapter,
- 6 and the maximum size and weight specified in this chapter -shall be
- 7 ARE lawful throughout this state, and local authorities shall not
- alter those size and weight limitations except as express authority

- 1 is granted in this chapter.
- 2 (2) The provisions of this chapter governing size, weight, and
- 3 load -shall DO not apply to a fire apparatus, to an implement of
- 4 husbandry incidentally moved upon a highway, a combination of
- 5 vehicles described in, and under the conditions provided by,
- 6 subsection (4), or to a vehicle operated under the terms of a
- 7 special permit issued as provided in this chapter.
- 8 (3) The state transportation department, -pursuant to UNDER
- 9 the administrative procedures act of 1969, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.201
- 10 to 24.328, may promulgate rules permitting and regulating the
- 11 operation of a vehicle or vehicles of a size or weight -which
- 12 exceeds— THAT EXCEED the size or weight limitations in this
- 13 chapter. The rules may restrict or proscribe the conditions of
- 14 operation of a vehicle or vehicles of a size or weight -which
- 15 exceeds THAT EXCEED the size or weight limitations in this
- 16 chapter, if the restriction or proscription is necessary to protect
- 17 the public safety or to prevent undue damage to a road foundation
- 18 or surface, a structure, or an installation. The rules may provide
- 19 for a reasonable inspection fee for an inspection of a vehicle or
- 20 vehicles to determine whether their sizes and weights are in
- 21 conformance with this act, and may require other security necessary
- 22 to compensate for damage caused by the vehicle or vehicles
- 23 described in this subsection.
- 24 (4) A wrecker and a disabled vehicle, or a wrecker and a
- 25 combination of a disabled vehicle and 1 trailer, that exceeds the
- 26 size and weight limitations in this chapter may be operated upon
- 27 the highways of this state under the following conditions:

- 1 (a) The wrecker is specifically designed for such towing
- 2 operations, is equipped with flashing, oscillating, or rotating
- 3 amber or red lights as permitted under section 698, and is capable
- 4 of utilizing the lighting and braking systems of the disabled
- 5 vehicle or combination of disabled vehicles if those systems are
- 6 operational.
- 7 (b) The FOR A COMBINATION OF DISABLED VEHICLES, THE wrecker
- 8 is issued an extended restricted permit under section 725 by the
- 9 state transportation department if each trip beginning from the
- 10 place of original disablement of the -disabled vehicle or
- 11 combination of **DISABLED** vehicles is  $\frac{25}{2}$  50 miles or less except
- 12 that, for each trip that begins and ends north of a line between
- 13 Ludington and Pinconning, the trip beginning from the place of
- 14 original disablement of the disabled vehicle or combination of
- vehicles may be  $\frac{50}{100}$  miles or less.
- 16 (C) FOR A DISABLED VEHICLE, THE WRECKER IS ISSUED AN EXTENDED
- 17 RESTRICTED PERMIT UNDER SECTION 725 BY THE STATE TRANSPORTATION
- 18 DEPARTMENT FOR THE TRANSPORT OF THE DISABLED VEHICLE.
- 19 (D) —(c)— The wrecker does not operate on any highway, road,
- 20 street, or structure included on a list provided by the state
- 21 transportation department unless the disabled vehicle or
- 22 combination of vehicles is located on 1 of those roads or
- 23 structures.
- 24 (5) The owner or operator of a wrecker that does not comply
- 25 with subsection -(4)(c) (4) (D) is responsible for a civil
- 26 infraction and shall pay a civil fine of not less than \$250.00 but
- 27 not OR more than \$500.00. The civil fine imposed by this

- 1 subsection is in addition to any fine that may be imposed under
- 2 section 724 or 725.
