A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 25b (MCL 257.25b), as added by 2000 PA 82.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1	Sec. 25b. "Low-speed vehicle" means an electrically powered
2	vehicle designed to be operated at a speed not to exceed 35 miles
3	per hour with a capacity of not more than 4 persons including the
4	driver of 2,200 pounds or less in weight as described in 49 C.F.R.
5	571.500 that is equipped with, but not limited to, the following:
6	(a) Headlamps.
7	(b) Front and rear turn signal lamps, tail lamps, and stop
8	lamps.
9	(c) Reflex reflectors: 1 red on each side as far to the rear
10	as practicable, and 1 red on the rear.

- 1 (d) An exterior mirror mounted on the driver's side of the
- 2 vehicle and either an exterior mirror mounted on the passenger's
- 3 side of the vehicle or an interior mirror.
- 4 (e) A parking brake.
- 5 (f) A windshield that meets the standards prescribed by this

- 7 (q) A vehicle identification number.
- 8 (h) A seat belt assembly conforming to the requirements of
- 9 this act installed at each designated seating position. A SELF-
- 10 PROPELLED, ELECTRONICALLY POWERED MOTOR VEHICLE THAT IS ALL OF THE
- 11 FOLLOWING:
- 12 (A) EMISSION-FREE.
- 13 (B) CONFORMS TO THE DEFINITION OF LOW-SPEED VEHICLE UNDER 49
- 14 CFR 571.3(B).
- 15 (C) MEETS THE STANDARD FOR LOW-SPEED VEHICLES UNDER 49 CFR
