THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 430a. (1) An individual shall not intentionally engage in
 or attempt to engage in human cloning.
 - (2) Subsection (1) does not prohibit scientific research or cell-based therapies not specifically prohibited by that subsection.
 - (3) An individual who violates subsection (1) is guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment for not more than -10— 15 years or a fine of not more than \$10,000,000.00, or both.
 - (4) As used in this section, "human cloning" means that term as defined in section 16274 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368,
