July 26, 2006, Introduced by Senator BROWN and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 1964 PA 154, entitled "Minimum wage law of 1964,"

by amending section 4b (MCL 408.384b), as added by 1997 PA 1.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 4b. (1) An employer may pay a new employee who is AT
- 2 LEAST 18 BUT less than 20 years of age a training hourly wage of
- 3 \$4.25 NOT LESS THAN \$5.15 for the first 90 days of that employee's
- 4 employment. The hourly wage authorized under this -section
 - SUBSECTION is in lieu of the minimum hourly wage otherwise
 - prescribed by this act.
 - (2) THE MINIMUM HOURLY WAGE FOR AN EMPLOYEE WHO IS LESS THAN
 - 18 YEARS OF AGE IS \$5.15.
