## **SENATE BILL No. 1365**

August 9, 2006, Introduced by Senators McMANUS, BIRKHOLZ, JELINEK, JOHNSON and HARDIMAN and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled

"Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 811e (MCL 257.811e), as amended by 2001 PA 124, and by adding section 811o.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 811e. (1) The secretary of state may develop a Michigan university fund-raising registration plate as described in this section, and a matching Michigan university collector plate as described in section 811g.
  - (2) The secretary of state may develop 1 or more limited term registration plates to recognize a state-sponsored event, a Michigan university, or an accomplishment or occasion of a Michigan university.

- 1 (3) The secretary of state may, at any 1 time, develop -not
- 2 more than 7 different state-sponsored fund-raising registration
- 3 plates as described in this section, and matching state-sponsored
- 4 collector plates as described in section 811q. As used in this
- 5 section, "state-sponsored fund-raising registration plate" means a
- 6 fund-raising registration plate authorized by a public act to raise
- 7 funds for a state-sponsored goal. The public act shall, at a
- 8 minimum, do all of the following:
- 9 (a) Identify the purpose of the state-sponsored fund-raising
- 10 registration plate.
- 11 (b) Create a fund or designate an existing fund to receive the
- 12 money raised through the sale of state-sponsored fund-raising
- 13 registration plates and matching collector plates.
- 14 (c) If a fund is created, name the person or entity
- 15 responsible for administering the fund.
- 16 (4) The secretary of state may develop, promote, and market
- 17 the fund-raising registration plates and matching collector plates
- 18 issued under this section with the funds available through service
- 19 fees.
- 20 (5) If the design or logo of a Michigan university fund-
- 21 raising registration plate or a state-sponsored fund-raising
- 22 registration plate uses 1 or more designs, trade names, trademarks,
- 23 service marks, emblems, symbols, or other images that are owned by
- 24 the Michigan university that is requesting the Michigan university
- 25 fund-raising plate, the person or entity that is sponsoring a
- 26 state-sponsored fund-raising plate, or any other person or entity,
- 27 the Michigan university or sponsoring person or entity shall grant

- 1 to or obtain for the secretary of state both of the following
- 2 pursuant— ACCORDING to a written agreement between the parties:
- 3 (a) A nonexclusive worldwide license to use those designs,
- 4 trade names, trademarks, service marks, emblems, symbols, or other
- 5 images on and in conjunction with the marketing, promotion, sale,
- 6 or copyrighting of the registration plate or image of the
- 7 registration plate.
- 8 (b) The authority to merchandise the registration plate or an
- 9 image of the registration plate.
- 10 (6) In using or employing a design, trade name, trademark,
- 11 service mark, emblem, symbol, logo, or other image on and in
- 12 conjunction with the marketing, promotion, sale, copyrighting, or
- 13 merchandising of a registration plate or image of the registration
- 14 plate, the secretary of state may alter the size of the design,
- 15 trade name, trademark, service mark, emblem, symbol, logo, or other
- 16 image but shall not change the color or design of the design, trade
- 17 name, trademark, service mark, emblem, symbol, logo, or other image
- 18 without the prior written consent of the respective Michigan
- 19 university or sponsoring person or entity. The secretary of state
- 20 shall not use or employ a design, trade name, trademark, service
- 21 mark, emblem, symbol, logo, or other image on and in conjunction
- 22 with the marketing, promotion, sale, copyrighting, or merchandising
- 23 of a registration plate or an image of the registration plate in
- 24 any manner that is offensive to the Michigan university or
- 25 sponsoring person or entity that complies with subsection (5).
- 26 (7) As used in this section, "Michigan university fund-raising
- 27 registration plate" means a fund-raising registration plate that is

- 1 issued under this section at the request of a Michigan university.
- 2 SEC. 811o. (1) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL DEVELOP UNDER
- 3 SECTION 811E AND ISSUE UNDER SECTION 811F A FUND-RAISING PLATE WITH
- 4 A FORESTRY THEME. THE SECRETARY OF STATE IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE
- 5 DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES SHALL DESIGN THE FORESTRY THEME
- 6 FUND-RAISING PLATES.
- 7 (2) THE OWNER OF A VEHICLE REQUIRED TO BE REGISTERED UNDER
- 8 THIS ACT MAY APPLY, ON A FORM PRESCRIBED BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE,
- 9 FOR A FORESTRY THEME FUND-RAISING PLATE AS PRESCRIBED IN SECTION
- 10 811F INSTEAD OF A STANDARD REGISTRATION PLATE.
- 11 (3) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL TRANSFER THE DONATION MONEY
- 12 FROM THE SALE OF FORESTRY THEME FUND-RAISING PLATES TO THE STATE
- 13 TREASURER, WHO SHALL CREDIT THE DONATION MONEY TO THE "ADOPT A
- 14 FOREST" FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBSECTION (4).
- 15 (4) THE "ADOPT A FOREST" FUND IS CREATED WITHIN THE STATE
- 16 TREASURY. THE STATE TREASURER MAY RECEIVE MONEY OR OTHER ASSETS
- 17 FROM ANY SOURCE FOR DEPOSIT INTO THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER
- 18 SHALL DIRECT THE INVESTMENT OF THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL
- 19 CREDIT TO THE FUND INTEREST AND EARNINGS FROM FUND INVESTMENTS.
- 20 MONEY IN THE FUND AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR SHALL REMAIN IN
- 21 THE FUND AND SHALL NOT LAPSE TO THE GENERAL FUND.
- 22 (5) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DISBURSE MONEY IN THE FUND ON A
- 23 QUARTERLY BASIS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES. BEGINNING
- 24 NOT LATER THAN FEBRUARY 1, 2008, THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL
- 25 RESOURCES SHALL SUBMIT TO THE STATE TREASURER A SUMMARY OF THE
- 26 EXPENDITURES DURING THE PRECEDING YEAR OF THE MONEY RECEIVED UNDER
- 27 THIS SECTION.

- 1 (6) THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES SHALL EXPEND THE MONEY
- 2 RECEIVED UNDER THIS SECTION SOLELY FOR THE "ADOPT A FOREST"
- 3 PROGRAM.
