August 9, 2006, Introduced by Senators BASHAM and JACOBS and referred to the Committee on Technology and Energy.

A bill to amend 1984 PA 431, entitled "The management and budget act,"

(MCL 18.1101 to 18.1594) by adding section 214.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 214. (1) BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2006, ALL NONROAD SPECIALTY
- 2 VEHICLES OWNED OR LEASED BY A STATE AGENCY THAT ARE USED IN A
- 3 COUNTY IN WHICH ALL OR A PART OF THAT COUNTY HAS BEEN DETERMINED BY
- 4 THE UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY AS NOT BEING IN
- 5 ATTAINMENT WITH THE NATIONAL AMBIENT AIR QUALITY STANDARDS FOR
- 6 OZONE UNDER THE CLEAN WATER ACT, 42 USC 7511, SHALL UTILIZE ULTRA-
- 7 LOW-SULFUR DIESEL FUEL AND THE BEST AVAILABLE TECHNOLOGY FOR
- 8 REDUCING THE EMISSION OF POLLUTANTS.
- 9 (2) BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2006, IF A STATE AGENCY ENTERS INTO A

 10 PROCUREMENT CONTRACT OR ANY OTHER CONTRACT IN WHICH THE CONTRACTOR

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- 1 MAY UTILIZE NONROAD SPECIALTY VEHICLES IN THE FULFILLMENT OF THE
- 2 CONTRACT THAT ARE USED IN A COUNTY IN WHICH ALL OR A PART OF THAT
- 3 COUNTY HAS BEEN DETERMINED BY THE UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL
- 4 PROTECTION AGENCY AS NOT BEING IN ATTAINMENT WITH THE NATIONAL
- 5 AMBIENT AIR QUALITY STANDARDS FOR OZONE UNDER THE CLEAN WATER ACT,
- 6 42 USC 7511, THE CONTRACT SHALL PROVIDE THAT THE CONTRACTOR SHALL
- 7 UTILIZE ONLY NONROAD SPECIALTY VEHICLES THAT UTILIZE ULTRA-LOW-
- 8 SULFUR DIESEL FUEL AND THE BEST AVAILABLE TECHNOLOGY FOR REDUCING
- 9 THE EMISSION OF POLLUTANTS IN FULFILLMENT OF THE CONTRACT.
- 10 (3) NOT LATER THAN OCTOBER 1, 2006, THE DIRECTOR SHALL ISSUE
- 11 DIRECTIVES TO EACH STATE AGENCY AS TO WHAT CONSTITUTES THE BEST
- 12 AVAILABLE TECHNOLOGY FOR REDUCING THE EMISSION OF POLLUTANTS OF
- 13 NONROAD SPECIALTY VEHICLES.
- 14 (4) TO THE EXTENT THEY ARE AVAILABLE, FEDERAL FUNDS SHALL BE
- 15 USED TO RETROFIT NONROAD SPECIALTY VEHICLES OWNED OR LEASED BY A
- 16 STATE AGENCY TO MAKE THEM COMPATIBLE WITH THE USE OF ULTRA-LOW-
- 17 SULFUR DIESEL FUEL.
- 18 (5) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 19 (A) "NONROAD SPECIALTY VEHICLE" MEANS A VEHICLE THAT IS
- 20 POWERED BY AN INTERNAL COMBUSTION ENGINE THAT IS 50-HORSEPOWER OR
- 21 GREATER AND FUELED BY DIESEL FUEL THAT IS NOT A MOTOR VEHICLE OR A
- 22 VEHICLE USED SOLELY FOR COMPETITION, WHICH SHALL INCLUDE, BUT IS
- 23 NOT LIMITED TO, AN EXCAVATOR, BACKHOE, CRANE, COMPRESSOR,
- 24 GENERATOR, BULLDOZER, AND SIMILAR EQUIPMENT.
- 25 (B) "ULTRA-LOW-SULFUR DIESEL FUEL" MEANS DIESEL FUEL THAT HAS
- 26 A SULFUR CONTENT OF NO MORE THAN 15 PARTS PER MILLION.
