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SENATE BILL No. 1378

August 9, 2006, Introduced by Senators BASHAM and JACOBS and referred to the Committee on Technology and Energy.

A bill to require local units of government to use ultra-lowsulfur diesel fuel in certain vehicles under certain conditions.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. (1) Beginning October 1, 2006, all nonroad specialty 2 vehicles owned or leased by a local unit of government in which all 3 or a part of that local unit of government has been determined by the United States environmental protection agency as not being in 5 attainment with the national ambient air quality standards for 6 ozone under the clean water act, 42 USC 7511, shall utilize ultra-7 low-sulfur diesel fuel and the best available technology for reducing the emission of pollutants.
 - (2) Beginning October 1, 2006, if a local unit of government

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- 1 enters into a procurement contract or any other contract in which
- 2 the contractor may utilize nonroad specialty vehicles in the
- 3 fulfillment of the contract that are used in a local unit of
- 4 government in which all or a part of that local unit of government
- 5 has been determined by the United States environmental protection
- 6 agency as not being in attainment with the national ambient air
- 7 quality standards for ozone under the clean water act, 42 USC 7511,
- 8 the contract shall provide that the contractor shall utilize only
- 9 nonroad specialty vehicles that utilize ultra-low-sulfur diesel
- 10 fuel and the best available technology for reducing the emission of
- 11 pollutants in fulfillment of the contract.
- 12 (3) To the extent they are available, federal funds shall be
- 13 used to retrofit nonroad specialty vehicles owned or leased by a
- 14 local unit of government to make them compatible with the use of
- 15 ultra-low-sulfur diesel fuel.
- 16 (4) As used in this act:
- 17 (a) "Local unit of government" means a county, city, village,
- 18 or township.
- 19 (b) "Nonroad specialty vehicle" means a vehicle that is
- 20 powered by an internal combustion engine that is 50-horsepower or
- 21 greater and fueled by diesel fuel that is not a motor vehicle or a
- vehicle used solely for competition, which shall include, but is
- 23 not limited to, an excavator, backhoe, crane, compressor,
- 24 generator, bulldozer, and similar equipment.
- 25 (c) "Ultra-low-sulfur diesel fuel" means diesel fuel that has
- 26 a sulfur content of no more than 15 parts per million.
