## A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4800 AS REPORTED FROM COMMITTEE

<u>House Bill 4800</u> would amend the State Employees' Retirement Act to suspend the retirement allowance payments of a retiree under the act if the individual is reemployed by the State of Michigan directly or indirectly (including through third-party contracts). The retirement payments would remain suspended during the period of reemployment. The pension suspension provision would begin on the effective date of the bill.
