### A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4843 AS INTRODUCED 5-24-07

The bill would amend the State Plumbing Act, 2002 PA 733 (MCL 338.3541 and 338.3545), to increase license and registration fees under the act as shown in the chart below.

**Note:** Under Section 23 of the State Plumbing Act, MCL 338.3533, a master plumber who is also a plumbing contractor is only required to pay the plumbing contractor fees.

The bill further provides the department with the authority to change the fee schedule by administrative rule.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

The bill would increase Construction Code Fund revenue by approximately \$1.2 million over the course of the next three fiscal years, barring any further changes to the fee schedule by the department through the promulgation of administrative rules.
