<ol> <li>Regional Training Institute. The Governor recommended the operational funding of a new Regional Training Institute in Battle Creek using restricted (revolving) funds.</li> </ol>	1,500,000
2. <b>Military Retirement Pay Increase.</b> GF/GP funds are added to pay for anticipated payments to retired Michigan Army and Air National Guard per P.A.150 of 1967 (\$74,000) and a Special duty Officer pay increase as provided by the National Defense Authorization Act (\$4,700).	78,900
<ol> <li>Grand Rapids Veterans Home Administrative Reductions. The Governor recommended a GF/GP administrative reduction for the Grand Rapids home.</li> </ol>	(370,000)
<ol> <li>Grand Rapids Veterans Home Fund Shifts. The Governor recommended a shift from GF/GP of \$630,000 to available federal funding.</li> </ol>	0
<ol> <li>D.J. Jacobetti Veterans Home Fund Shift. The Governor recommended a shift from GF/GP of \$277,400 to available restricted and Federal funding.</li> </ol>	0
<ol><li>Armory Maintenance. The Governor recommended the elimination of four vacant armory maintenance mechanics for a GF/GP savings.</li></ol>	(300,000)
7. <b>Federal Support for Facilities.</b> The Governor recommended available additional Federal support for Headquarters and Armories (\$600,000) and training sites and logistical facilities (\$175,000).	775,000
8. <b>Human Resources Optimization.</b> The Governor recommended an adjustment to reflect increased user charges (\$1,700) and removal of capitalization of hardware and software costs added in FY 2005-06 (\$14,700).	(13,000)
<ol> <li>Sick Leave Payouts. The Governor recommended the inclusion of non-DIT GF/GP savings related to the five year payout of sick leave for FY 2001-02 early retirees.</li> </ol>	(43,100)
10. Adjustment for Executive Order 2007-3 Reductions, P.A. 17 and P.A. 41 of 2007.	(859,400)
11. <b>Placeholder Increases.</b> The Senate added \$1,000 to several line items (Special Maintenance-State, Grand Rapids Veterans Home and each Veterans Service Organization grant recipient) balanced by administrative reductions.	0
12. <b>Unmanned Aerial Vehicle.</b> The Senate added a placeholder appropriation of \$1,000 (offset by administrative reductions) for an unmanned aerial vehicle.	0
13. Budgetary Savings. The Senate added a GF/GP reduction unit.	(862,000)
14. Economic Adjustments. Adjustments include a GF/GP total of \$1,723,900.	3,295,700
15. <b>Other Changes.</b> The Governor recommended an increase for the Starbase program (\$57,000), the Mackinac Bridge walk security costs (\$5,000) and reductions for Information Technology (\$3,600) and lease revenue from the Grand Rapids Home (\$22,800).	35,600
16. <b>Comparison to Governor's Recommendation.</b> The Senate is \$862,000 Gross and \$862,000 GF/GP under the Governor.

## Changes from FY 2005-06 Year to Date:

## **New Boilerplate Sections**

- 1. **Legal Services.** The Senate added a new section prohibiting the hiring of any legal services which could be performed by the Attorney General. (Sec. 228)
- 2. **Regional Training Institute (RTI) Creation.** States creation and purpose of new training facility in Battle Creek with funding from a revolving account. Requires Legislative report. (Sec. 229)
- 3. **Regional Training Institute (RTI) Guidelines for Usage.** States availability for use by various entities of the RTI. (Sec. 230)
- 4. **Policy Change Reports.** The Senate added new language requiring the reporting of any policy changes made to implement enacted legislation be made to the Legislature. (Sec. 231)
- 5. **Budgetary Reduction.** The Senate added new language requiring reductions made via the budgetary reduction unit be accomplished by Legislative transfer. (Sec. 232)

## **Amended Boilerplate Sections**

- 6. **Hiring Freeze.** The Senate added a revised version of current-year language requiring a Civil Service hiring freeze. (Sec. 205)
- 7. **Buy American.** The Senate added a revised version of current-year language requiring a priority be given to American/Michigan businesses when State purchases are made by adding a priority to those owned and operated by veterans. (Sec. 209)
