SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4064

A bill to establish the home heating credit fund in the department of treasury; to provide for the distribution of the money from the fund; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain agencies and officials; and to provide for appropriations.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "home
- 2 heating credit fund act".
- 3 Sec. 3. As used in this act:
- 4 (a) "Department" means the department of treasury.
- 5 (b) "Fund" means the home heating credit fund created in
- 6 section 5.
- 7 Sec. 5. (1) The home heating credit fund is created within the
- 8 state treasury. The department shall be the administrator of the
- 9 fund for auditing purposes.

- 1 (2) The state treasurer shall credit to the fund all amounts
- 2 appropriated for this purpose under section 435 of the income tax
- 3 act of 1967, 1967 PA 281, MCL 206.435, and money from any other
- 4 source for deposit into the fund.
- 5 (3) The state treasurer shall direct the investment of the
- 6 fund. The fund shall consist of the money credited to the fund
- 7 pursuant to section 435 of the income tax act of 1967, 1967 PA 281,
- 8 MCL 206.435, any interest and earnings accruing from the saving and
- 9 investment of that money, and money from any other source.
- 10 (4) Money in the fund at the close of the year shall remain in
- 11 the fund and shall not lapse to the general fund.
- Sec. 7. The money, interest, and earnings of the fund shall be
- 13 expended to pay home heating credits claimed pursuant to section
- 14 527a of the income tax act of 1967, 1967 PA 281, MCL 206.527a, to
- 15 the extent that credits under that section are not fully funded
- 16 pursuant to section 527a(19) of that act. The money in the home
- 17 heating credit fund shall not be used to replace funds otherwise
- 18 designated to fund the credits under section 527a of the income tax
- 19 act of 1967, 1967 PA 281, MCL 206.527a.
- 20 Sec. 9. The money in the fund that is available for
- 21 distribution shall be appropriated each year. Money granted or
- 22 received as a gift or donation to the fund is available for
- 23 distribution upon appropriation.
- 24 Enacting section 1. This act does not take effect unless House
- 25 Bill No. 4280 of the 94th Legislature is enacted into law.
