SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4471

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 40102 (MCL 324.40102), as amended by 2000 PA 347.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 40102. (1) "Animals" means wild birds and wild mammals.
- (2) "Bag limit" means the number of animals that may be takenand possessed as determined by the department.
- 4 (3) "Bow" means a device for propelling an arrow from a string 5 drawn, held, and released by hand where the force used to hold the 6 string in the drawn position is provided by the archer's muscles.
- 7 (4) "Buy" or "sell" means an exchange or attempt or offer to 8 exchange for money, barter, or anything of value.
- 9 (5) "Chase" means to follow animals with dogs or other wild or

- 1 domestic animals trained for that purpose.
- 2 (6) "CORMORANT DAMAGE" MEANS ADVERSE IMPACTS OF DOUBLE-CRESTED

- 4 PLANTS, AND THEIR HABITATS [AND ON MAN-MADE STRUCTURES].
- 5 (7) "CORMORANT DEPREDATION ORDER" MEANS THE DEPREDATION ORDER

- 9 (8) (6) "Crossbow" means a weapon consisting of a bow mounted

- 12 controlled by a mechanical or electric trigger and has a working
- 13 safety and a draw weight of 100 pounds or greater.
- 14 (9) (7) "Deer or elk feeding" means the depositing,
- 15 distributing, or tending of feed in an area frequented by wild,
- 16 free-ranging white-tailed deer or elk. Deer or elk feeding does not
- include any of the following:
- 18 (a) Feeding wild birds or other wildlife if done in such a
- 19 manner as to exclude wild, free-ranging white-tailed deer and elk
- 20 from gaining access to the feed.
- 21 (b) The scattering of feed solely as the result of normal
- 22 logging practices or normal agricultural practices.
- (c) The storage or use of feed for agricultural purposes if 1
- 24 or more of the following apply:
- 25 (i) The area is occupied by livestock actively consuming the
- 26 feed on a daily basis.
- 27 (ii) The feed is covered to deter wild, free-ranging white-

- 4 (d) Baiting to take game as provided by an order of the

- 6 (10) (8) "Disability" means a determinable physical
- 7 characteristic of an individual that may result from disease,
- 8 injury, congenital condition of birth, or functional disorder.
- 9 (11) (9) "Feed" means a substance composed of grain, mineral,
- 10 salt, fruit, vegetable, hay, or any other food material or
- 11 combination of these materials, whether natural or manufactured,
- 12 that may attract white-tailed deer or elk. Feed does not include
- 13 any of the following:
- 14 (a) Plantings for wildlife.
- 15 (b) Standing farm crops under normal agricultural practices.
- 16 (c) Agricultural commodities scattered solely as the result of
- 17 normal agricultural practices.
- 18 (12) (10)—"Firearm" means a weapon from which a dangerous
- 19 projectile may be propelled by using explosives, gas, or air. as a
- 20 means of propulsion. Firearm does not include a smooth bore rifle
- 21 or handqun designed and manufactured exclusively for propelling
- 22 BB's not exceeding .177 caliber by means of a spring, or air, or
- 23 qas.
