SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4591

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code,"

by amending sections 1538 and 1539 (MCL 380.1538 and 380.1539), section 1538 as added by 1988 PA 339 and section 1539 as amended by 2004 PA 76, and by adding sections 1531h and 1538a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 11 (5) For the state fiscal year ending September 30, 2004,
- 12 \$1,000,000.00 is transferred from the teacher-administrator
- 13 preparation and certification fund to the unappropriated balance
- 14 of the general fund for the state fiscal year ending September
- **15** 30, 2004.
