## SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4552

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

by amending section 50b (MCL 750.50b), as amended by 1996 PA 80.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 50b. (1) As used in this section, "animal" means any
- vertebrate other than a human being.
- 3 (2) A-EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, A person
- 4 who willfully, maliciously and without just cause or excuse kills,
- 5 tortures, mutilates, maims, or disfigures SHALL NOT DO ANY OF THE
- 6 FOLLOWING WITHOUT JUST CAUSE:
- 7 (A) KNOWINGLY KILL, TORTURE, MUTILATE, MAIM, OR DISFIGURE an
- 8 animal. or who willfully and maliciously and without just cause or
- 9 excuse administers
- 10 (B) COMMIT A RECKLESS ACT KNOWING OR HAVING REASON TO KNOW

- 1 THAT THE ACT WILL CAUSE AN ANIMAL TO BE KILLED, TORTURED,
- 2 MUTILATED, MAIMED, OR DISFIGURED.
- 3 (C) KNOWINGLY ADMINISTER poison to an animal, or exposes
- 4 KNOWINGLY EXPOSE an animal to any poisonous substance, other than a
- 5 substance that is used for therapeutic veterinary medical purposes
- 6 —with the intent that the substance be taken or swallowed by the
- 7 animal. -
- 8 (3) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (2) is guilty of a felony
- 9 \_\_punishable by imprisonment 1 OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 10 (A) IMPRISONMENT for not more than 4 years. , or by a
- 11 (B) A fine of not more than \$5,000.00 , or community FOR A
- 12 SINGLE ANIMAL AND \$2,500.00 FOR EACH ADDITIONAL ANIMAL INVOLVED IN
- 13 THE VIOLATION, BUT NOT TO EXCEED A TOTAL OF \$20,000.00.
- 14 (C) COMMUNITY service for not more than 500 hours. or any
- 15 combination of these penalties.
- 16 (4) (3) As a part of the sentence for a violation of
- 17 subsection (2), the court may order the defendant to pay the costs
- 18 of the prosecution and the costs of the care, housing, and
- 19 veterinary medical care for the impacted animal victim, as
- 20 applicable. If the court does not order a defendant to pay all of
- 21 the applicable costs listed in this subsection, or orders only
- 22 partial payment of these costs, the court shall state on the record
- 23 the reasons for that action.
- 24 (5)  $\frac{4}{1}$  If a term of probation is ordered for a violation of
- 25 subsection (2), the court may order, INCLUDE as a condition of THAT
- 26 probation —that the defendant be evaluated to determine the need
- 27 for psychiatric or psychological counseling —and, if determined

- 1 appropriate by the court, to receive psychiatric or psychological
- 2 counseling at his or her own expense.
- 3 (6) (5) As a part of the sentence for a violation of
- 4 subsection (2), the court may order the defendant not to own or
- 5 possess an animal for any period of time determined by the court,
- 6 which may include permanent relinquishment.
- 7 (7) (6) A person who owns or possesses an animal in violation
- 8 of an order issued under subsection (5) (6) is subject to
- 9 revocation of probation if the order is issued as a condition of
- 10 probation. A person who owns or possesses an animal in violation of
- 11 an order issued under subsection (5) (6) is also subject to the
- 12 civil and criminal contempt power of the court , and, if found
- 13 guilty of criminal contempt, may be punished by imprisonment for
- 14 not more than 90 days , or by a fine of not more than \$500.00, or
- **15** both.
- 16 (8) (7) This section does not prohibit the lawful killing of
- 17 livestock or a customary animal husbandry or farming practice
- 18 involving livestock. As used in this subsection, "livestock" has
- 19 the meaning attributed to the MEANS THAT term AS DEFINED in SECTION
- 20 5 OF the animal industry act, of 1987, Act No. 466 of the Public
- 21 Acts of 1988, being sections 287.701 to 287.747 of the Michigan
- 22 Compiled Laws 1988 PA 466, MCL 287.705.
- 23 (9) (8)—This section does not prohibit the lawful killing of
- 24 an animal pursuant to any of the following:
- 25 (a) Fishing.
- 26 (b) Hunting, trapping, or wildlife control regulated pursuant
- 27 to part 401 (wildlife conservation) of UNDER the natural resources

- 1 and environmental protection act, Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1994, being sections 324.40101 to 324.40119 of the Michigan
- 3 Compiled Laws 1994 PA 451, MCL 324.101 TO 324.90106, and orders
- 4 issued under that act.
- 5 (c) Pest or rodent control regulated pursuant to UNDER part 83
- 6 (pesticide control) of Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1994,
- 7 being sections 324.8301 to 324.8336 of the Michigan Compiled Laws
- 8 OF THE NATURAL RESOURCES AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT, 1994 PA
- 9 451, MCL 324.8301 TO 324.8336.
- 10 (d) Activities authorized pursuant to UNDER rules promulgated
- 11 under section 9 of the executive organization act of 1965, Act No.
- 12 380 of the Public Acts of 1965, being section 16.109 of the
- 13 Michigan Compiled Laws 1965 PA 380, MCL 16.109.
- 14 (E) SECTION 19 OF THE DOG LAW OF 1919, 1919 PA 339, MCL
- 15 287.279.
- 16 (10) (9) This section does not prohibit the lawful killing or
- 17 use of an animal for scientific research pursuant to UNDER any of
- 18 the following or a rule promulgated pursuant to UNDER any of the
- **19** following:
- 20 (a) Act No. 224 of the Public Acts of 1969, being sections
- 21 287.381 to 287.395 of the Michigan Compiled Laws 1969 PA 224, MCL
- 22 287.381 TO 287.395.
- 23 (b) Sections 2226, 2671, 2676, 7109, and 7333 of the public
- 24 health code, Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, being sections
- 25 333.2226, 333.2671, 333.2676, 333.7109, and 333.7333 of the
- 26 Michigan Compiled Laws 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.2226, 333.2671,
- 27 333.2676, 333.7109, AND 333.7333.
