SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4849

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 8317 (MCL 324.8317), as amended by 2003 PA 82; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 8317. (1) An application submitted under this part shall
- 2 be accompanied by the following application fee:
- 3 (a) For a commercial applicator certification, \$75.00.
- 4 (b) For a private agricultural applicator certification,
- 5 \$50.00 if paid on October 1, 2003 through September 30, 2007, and
- 6 \$10.00 if paid through September 30, 2003 or after September 30,
- 7 2007 UNTIL SEPTEMBER 30, 2012 AND \$10.00 AFTER SEPTEMBER 30, 2012.
- **8** (c) For a commercial registered applicator, \$45.00.

- 1 (d) For a private registered applicator, \$50.00 if paid on
- 2 October 1, 2003 through September 30, 2007, and \$10.00 if paid
- 3 through September 30, 2003 or after September 30, 2007 UNTIL
- 4 SEPTEMBER 30, 2012 AND \$10.00 AFTER SEPTEMBER 30, 2012.
- 5 (2) Certificates for commercial applicators, private
- 6 agricultural applicators, and registered applicators shall be valid
- 7 for a period of time of not less than 3 years to be established by
- 8 rule by the director.
- 9 (3) The license application fee for a commercial applicator
- 10 license is \$100.00. The license shall expire on December 31
- **11** annually.
- 12 (4) The registration application fee for the registration of
- 13 pesticides sold, offered, exposed for sale, or distributed is
- **14** \$40.00 per product.
- 15 (5) The license application fee for a restricted use pesticide
- 16 dealer's license is \$100.00. The license shall expire annually on
- 17 December 31.
- 18 (6) Application fees submitted under this section are not
- 19 refundable.
- 20 (7) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEPOSIT LICENSE AND ADMINISTRATIVE
- 21 FEES AND ADMINISTRATIVE, CIVIL, AND NONCRIMINAL FINES RECEIVED, AS
- 22 WELL AS ANY PAYMENT FOR COSTS OR REIMBURSEMENT TO THE DEPARTMENT
- 23 FOR INVESTIGATION, UNDER THIS PART IN THE AGRICULTURE LICENSING AND
- 24 INSPECTION FEES FUND CREATED IN SECTION 9 OF THE INSECT PEST AND
- 25 PLANT DISEASE ACT, 1931 PA 189, MCL 286.209, TO BE USED PURSUANT TO
- 26 APPROPRIATION BY THE DIRECTOR IN ADMINISTERING AND CARRYING OUT
- 27 THOSE DUTIES REQUIRED BY LAW UNDER THIS PART.

- 4 Enacting section 2. Section 8318 of the natural resources and
- 5 environmental protection act, 1994 PA 451, MCL 324.8318, is
- 6 repealed.
