## SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5034

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 8501 (MCL 324.8501), as amended by 2006 PA 503.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 8501. As used in this part:
- 2 (a) "Adulterated product" means a product which THAT contains
- 3 any deleterious or harmful substance in sufficient amount to render
- 4 it injurious to beneficial plant life, animals, humans, aquatic
- 5 life, soil or water when applied in accordance with directions for
- 6 use on the label, or if adequate warning statements or directions
- 7 for use which THAT may be necessary to protect plant life, animals,
- 8 humans, aquatic life, soil or water are not shown on the label.
- 9 (B) "AGRICULTURAL USE" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION

- 1 36101.
- 2 (C) (b) "Aquifer" means a geologic formation, group of
- 3 formations, or part of a formation capable of yielding a
- 4 significant amount of groundwater to wells or springs.
- 5 (D) (c)—"Aquifer sensitivity" means a hydrogeologic function
- 6 representing the inherent abilities of materials surrounding the
- 7 aquifer to attenuate the movement of nitrogen fertilizers into that
- 8 aquifer.
- 9 (E) (d)—"Aquifer sensitivity region" means an area in which
- 10 aguifer sensitivity estimations are sufficiently uniform to warrant
- 11 their classification as a unit.
- (F) (e) "Brand or product name" means a term, design, or
- 13 trademark used in connection with 1 or more grades of fertilizer.
- 14 (G) (f) "Bulk fertilizer" means fertilizer distributed in a
- 15 nonpackaged form.
- 16 (H) (g) "Custom blend" means a fertilizer blended according to
- 17 specifications provided to a blender in a soil test nutrient
- 18 recommendation or blended as specifically requested by the consumer
- 19 prior to blending.
- 20 (I) (h)—"Department" means the department of agriculture.
- 21 (J) (i) "Director" means the director of the department of
- 22 agriculture or his or her designee.
- 23 (K) (j) "Distribute" means to import, consign, sell, barter,
- 24 offer for sale, solicit orders for sale, or otherwise supply
- 25 fertilizer for sale or use in this state.
- 26 (l) (k) "Distributor" means any person who distributes
- 27 fertilizer for sale or use in this state.

- 1 (M) (l)—"Fertilizer" means a substance containing 1 or more
- 2 recognized plant nutrients, which substance is used for its plant
- 3 nutrient content and which is designed for use, or claimed to have
- 4 value, in promoting plant growth. Fertilizer does not include
- 5 unmanipulated animal and vegetable manures, marl, lime, limestone,
- 6 wood ashes, and other materials exempted by rules promulgated under
- 7 this part.
- 8 (N) (m) "Fertilizer material" means a fertilizer that is any
- 9 of the following:
- 10 (i) Contains not more than 1 of the following as primary
- 11 nutrients:
- 12 (A) Total nitrogen (N).
- 13 (B) Available phosphate  $(P_2O_5)$ .
- 14 (C) Soluble potash  $(K_2O)$ .
- 15 (ii) Has 85% or more of its plant nutrient content present in
- 16 the form of a single chemical compound.
- 17 (iii) Is derived from a plant or animal residue or by-product or
- 18 natural material deposit which THAT has been processed in such a
- 19 way that its content of plant nutrients has not been materially
- 20 changed except by purification and concentration.
- 21 (0) <del>(n) "Fund" means the fertilizer control fund created under</del>
- 22 section 8514.
- (P) (o)—"Grade" means the percentage guarantee of total
- 24 nitrogen (N), available phosphate  $(P_2O_5)$ , and soluble potash  $(K_2O)$ ,
- 25 of a fertilizer and shall be stated in the same order given in this
- 26 subdivision. Indication of grade does not apply to peat or peat
- 27 moss or soil conditioners.

- 1 (Q)  $\frac{(p)}{(p)}$  "Groundwater" means underground water within the zone
- 2 of saturation.
- 3 (R) (q) "Groundwater stewardship practices" means any of a set
- 4 of voluntary practices adopted by the commission of agriculture
- 5 pursuant to part 87, designed to protect groundwater from
- 6 contamination by fertilizers.
- 7 (S) (r) "Guaranteed analysis" means the minimum percentage of
- 8 each plant nutrient guaranteed or claimed to be present.
- 9 (T) (s)—"Label" means any written, printed, or graphic matter
- 10 on or attached to packaged fertilizer or used to identify
- 11 fertilizer distributed in bulk or held in bulk storage.
- 12 (U) (t) "Labeling" means all labels and other written,
- 13 printed, electronic, or graphic matter upon or accompanying any
- 14 fertilizer at any time, and includes advertising, sales literature,
- 15 brochures, posters, and internet, television, and radio
- 16 announcements used in promoting the sale of that fertilizer.
- 17 (V) (u)—"Licensee" means the person who receives a license to
- 18 manufacture or distribute fertilizers under this part.
- 19 (W) (v)—"Lot" means an identifiable quantity of fertilizer
- 20 that can be sampled officially according to methods adopted under
- 21 section 8510, that amount contained in a single vehicle, or that
- 22 amount delivered under a single invoice.
- 23 (X) (w)—"Manufacture" means to process, granulate, compound,
- 24 produce, mix, blend, or alter the composition of fertilizer or
- 25 fertilizer materials.
- 26 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 27 unless House Bill No. 5035 of the 94th Legislature is enacted into

1 law.
