

SUBSTITUTE FOR
HOUSE BILL NO. 5630

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled
"Natural resources and environmental protection act,"
by amending section 30929 (MCL 324.30929), as added by 2004 PA 522.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 30929. A lake board for a public **OR PRIVATE** inland lake
2 is dissolved if all of the following requirements are met:

3 (a) The governing body of each local unit of government in
4 which all or part of the lake is located holds a public hearing on
5 the proposed dissolution, determines that the lake board is no
6 longer necessary for the improvement of the lake because the
7 reasons for the establishment of the lake board no longer exist,
8 and approves the dissolution of the lake board. ~~The~~**FOR A PUBLIC**
9 **LAKE, THE** governing body of each local unit of government in which

1 all or part of the lake is located may hold the public hearing on
2 the dissolution of the lake board on its own initiative. ~~The~~**FOR A**
3 **PUBLIC OR PRIVATE LAKE, THE** governing body of each local unit of
4 government in which all or part of the lake is located shall hold a
5 public hearing on the dissolution of the lake board upon petition
6 of 2/3 of the freeholders owning land abutting the lake. Notice of
7 the public hearing shall be published twice in a newspaper of
8 general circulation in each local unit of government in which all
9 or part of the lake is located. The first notice shall be published
10 not less than 10 days before the date of the hearing.

11 (b) All outstanding indebtedness and expenses of the lake
12 board are paid in full.

13 (c) Any excess funds of the lake board are refunded based on
14 the last approved special assessment roll. However, if the amount
15 of excess funds is de minimis, the excess funds shall be
16 distributed to the local units of government in which all or part
17 of the lake is located, apportioned based on the amounts assessed
18 against each local unit of government and lands in that local unit
19 on the last approved special assessment roll.

20 (d) The lake board determines that it is no longer necessary
21 for the improvement of the lake, because the reasons for its
22 establishment no longer exist, and adopts an order approving its
23 dissolution.
