Sec. 201. In accordance with the provisions of section 30 of

- 1 article IX of the state constitution of 1963, total state spending
- 2 from state resources in this appropriation act for the fiscal year
- 3 ending September 30, 2009 is \$13,286,600.00 and state
- 4 appropriations paid to local units of government are \$5,227,400.00.

- 7 to 18.1594. The itemized statement below identifies appropriations
