SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5995

A bill to amend 1943 PA 148, entitled

"An act to provide for the regulation and licensing of proprietary schools in the state; to require surety; to provide for collection and disposition of fees; and to prescribe penalties for the violation of this act,"

by amending the title and sections 1, 1a, 2, 2a, 2b, and 3 (MCL 395.101, 395.101a, 395.102, 395.102a, 395.102b, and 395.103), the title and sections 1, 2, 2a, 2b, and 3 as amended and section 1a as added by 1983 PA 60, and by adding sections 2c and 2d.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 2 An act to provide for the regulation and licensing of

- 1 AND DUTIES OF CERTAIN STATE GOVERNMENTAL OFFICERS AND ENTITIES; to

- 5 Sec. 1. (1) A proprietary school shall secure from the board a
- 6 license issued in the form prescribed by the board and in
- 7 accordance with this act. A CAREER SCHOOL SHALL NOT OPERATE IN THIS
- 8 STATE WITHOUT A LICENSE OR TEMPORARY PERMIT FROM THE DEPARTMENT
- 9 UNDER THIS ACT. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PRESCRIBE THE FORM OF LICENSE
- 10 AND TEMPORARY PERMIT.
- 11 (2) A license issued under this act shall be—IS NOT valid for
- 12 not more than 1 year. If the applicant THE DEPARTMENT MAY RENEW THE

- Sec. 2. (1) A license shall not be issued until the applicant
- 21 THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT ISSUE A LICENSE TO A CAREER SCHOOL UNDER
- 22 THIS ACT UNLESS THE CAREER SCHOOL has operated IN THIS STATE under
- 23 a temporary permit FROM THE DEPARTMENT in a manner satisfactory to
- 24 the board DEPARTMENT and until the board DEPARTMENT has approved
- 25 the method and content of the advertising, the standards and the

- 21 A GRIEVANCE PROCEDURE FOR STUDENTS THAT INCLUDES A RIGHT TO FILE A
- 22 COMPLAINT WITH THE DEPARTMENT FOR ANY VIOLATION OF THIS ACT OR
- 23 RULES.
- 24 SEC. 2D. (1) A CAREER SCHOOL MAY SELL GOODS PRODUCED OR
- 25 SERVICES PROVIDED BY A STUDENT ENROLLED IN AN EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM
- 26 OPERATED BY THE SCHOOL IF ALL OF THE FOLLOWING ARE MET:
- 27 (A) THE PROGRAM INCLUDES CLASSROOM STUDY AND PRACTICAL

- 1 TRAINING.
- 2 (B) ANY PRACTICAL TRAINING INCLUDED IN THE PROGRAM IS
- 3 SUPERVISED BY A MEMBER OF THE FACULTY.
- 4 (C) IT IS AN INTEGRAL PART OF THE PROGRAM THAT THE STUDENT
- 5 ENGAGE IN PRODUCING THE GOODS OR PROVIDING THE SERVICES AS PART OF
- 6 HIS OR HER PRACTICAL TRAINING.
- 7 (D) INCOME FROM THE SALE OF GOODS PRODUCED AND SERVICES
- 8 PROVIDED BY STUDENTS IN THE PROGRAM DOES NOT EXCEED 15% OF THE
- 9 PROGRAM'S TOTAL ANNUAL INCOME.
- 10 (E) MONEY FROM THE SALE OF THE GOODS OR SERVICES IS USED
- 11 SOLELY TO SUPPORT THE SCHOOL AND DOES NOT INVOLVE PECUNIARY GAIN OR
- 12 PROFIT OR ANY OTHER ADVANTAGE OR COMPENSATION FOR ITS OFFICERS,
- 13 DIRECTORS, SHAREHOLDERS, MEMBERS, OR FACULTY.
- 14 (F) THE SCHOOL DOES NOT CHARGE A STUDENT A MONETARY PENALTY OR
- 15 INCREASE HIS OR HER PROGRAM HOURS BEYOND THE NUMBER APPROVED BY THE
- 16 DEPARTMENT IF HE OR SHE DOES NOT ATTEND ANY PRACTICAL TRAINING.
- 17 (G) A STUDENT ENGAGED IN PRODUCING GOODS OR PROVIDING SERVICES
- 18 AS PART OF HIS OR HER PRACTICAL TRAINING DOES NOT DISPLACE A
- 19 REGULAR EMPLOYEE.
- 20 (H) A STUDENT ENROLLED IN THE PROGRAM IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR
- 21 RECRUITING PURCHASERS OF THE GOODS OR SERVICES.
- 22 (I) THE SCHOOL PROVIDES A WRITTEN NOTICE TO ANY STUDENT
- 23 APPLYING TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM AND ANY PROSPECTIVE
- 24 PURCHASERS OF GOODS AND SERVICES THAT DISCLOSES THAT THE GOODS AND
- 25 SERVICES ARE PROVIDED BY STUDENTS.
- 26 (J) THE SCHOOL HAS OBTAINED THE APPROVAL OF THE DEPARTMENT
- 27 DESCRIBED IN THIS SECTION.

- 1 (2) A CAREER SCHOOL SHALL NOT OPERATE AN EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM
- 2 DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1), OR SELL GOODS PRODUCED OR SERVICES
- 3 PROVIDED BY A STUDENT ENROLLED IN THAT PROGRAM, WITHOUT THE WRITTEN
- 4 APPROVAL OF THE DEPARTMENT.
- 5 (3) AN APPROVAL OR RENEWAL OF AN APPROVAL UNDER THIS SECTION
- 6 IS VALID FOR 1 YEAR.
- 7 (4) THE DEPARTMENT MAY RENEW AN APPROVAL DESCRIBED IN THIS
- 8 SECTION IF THE CAREER SCHOOL CONTINUES TO COMPLY WITH THIS SECTION
- 9 AND ANY RULES PROMULGATED UNDER THIS SECTION. A CAREER SCHOOL
- 10 REQUESTING RENEWAL OF AN APPROVAL SHALL SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR
- 11 RENEWAL TO THE DEPARTMENT, IN THE FORM PRESCRIBED BY THE
- 12 DEPARTMENT, AND INCLUDE WITH THE APPLICATION ANY FINANCIAL
- 13 INFORMATION REQUESTED BY THE DEPARTMENT THAT DEMONSTRATES THE
- 14 CAREER SCHOOL'S COMPLIANCE WITH SUBSECTION (1) IN THE PRECEDING
- 15 YEAR.
- 16 (5) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REVOKE AN APPROVAL GRANTED UNDER THIS
- 17 SECTION IF THE CAREER SCHOOL'S LICENSE UNDER THIS ACT IS REVOKED.
- 18 THE DEPARTMENT MAY REVOKE AN APPROVAL GRANTED UNDER THIS SECTION AT
- 19 ANY TIME IF THE DEPARTMENT DETERMINES THAT THE CAREER SCHOOL TO
- 20 WHICH THE APPROVAL IS GRANTED IS NOT COMPLYING WITH THIS SECTION OR
- 21 ANY RULES PROMULGATED UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 22 (6) ANY FINANCIAL INFORMATION PROVIDED TO THE DEPARTMENT BY A
- 23 CAREER SCHOOL UNDER THIS SECTION IS CONFIDENTIAL AND IS NOT SUBJECT
- 24 TO THE DISCLOSURE REQUIREMENTS OF THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT,
- 25 1976 PA 442, MCL 15.231 TO 15.246, EXCEPT THAT DISCLOSURE OF
- 26 FINANCIAL INFORMATION MAY BE MADE IN ANY OF THE FOLLOWING
- 27 CIRCUMSTANCES:

- 1 (A) WITH THE WRITTEN CONSENT OF THE SCHOOL.
- 2 (B) PURSUANT TO A COURT PROCEEDING.
- 3 (C) THE DISCLOSURE IS MADE TO AN AGENT OR EMPLOYEE OF THE
- 4 DEPARTMENT.
- 5 (D) THE DISCLOSURE IS MADE TO AN AGENT OR EMPLOYEE OF A STATE
- 6 OR THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT AUTHORIZED BY LAW TO SEE OR REVIEW THE
- 7 INFORMATION.
- 8 Sec. 3. (1) IN LIEU OF REVOCATION UNDER SECTION 1(3), THE
- 9 DEPARTMENT MAY ASSESS AN ADMINISTRATIVE FINE AGAINST A CAREER
- 10 SCHOOL OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,000.00 FOR A VIOLATION OF THIS ACT OR
- 11 RULES PROMULGATED UNDER THIS ACT. HOWEVER, THE DEPARTMENT MAY NOT
- 12 ASSESS ADMINISTRATIVE FINES UNDER THIS SUBSECTION AGAINST A CAREER
- 13 SCHOOL THAT IN THE AGGREGATE ARE MORE THAN \$10,000.00 FOR MULTIPLE
- 14 VIOLATIONS OF THIS ACT OR RULES PROMULGATED UNDER THIS ACT THAT
- 15 ARISE FROM THE SAME TRANSACTION.
- 16 (2) A person who CAREER SCHOOL THAT violates this act shall be
- 17 AND HAS ITS LICENSE REVOKED, OR THAT OPERATES IN THIS STATE WITHOUT
- 18 A LICENSE, IS guilty of a misdemeanor , punishable by a fine not to
- 19 exceed \$1,000.00 OF NOT MORE THAN \$50,000.00, or imprisonment for a
- 20 period not to exceed 90 days NOT MORE THAN 1 YEAR, or both.
