

SUBSTITUTE FOR
HOUSE BILL NO. 6714

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled
"Natural resources and environmental protection act,"
(MCL 324.101 to 324.90106) by adding sections 17315, 17321, and
17333.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 17315. (1) COVERED ELECTRONIC DEVICES COLLECTED UNDER
2 THIS PART SHALL BE RECYCLED IN A MANNER THAT COMPLIES WITH FEDERAL
3 AND STATE LAWS, INCLUDING RULES PROMULGATED BY THE DEPARTMENT, AND
4 LOCAL ORDINANCES.

5 (2) ANY RULES PROMULGATED BY THE DEPARTMENT UNDER SECTION
6 17321 REGULATING THE RECYCLING OF COVERED ELECTRONIC DEVICES
7 COLLECTED UNDER THIS PART SHALL BE CONSISTENT WITH BOTH OF THE
8 FOLLOWING:

9 (A) THE UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY'S "PLUG-

1 IN TO RECYCLING GUIDELINES FOR MATERIALS MANAGEMENT", AS IN EFFECT
2 ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS
3 SECTION.

4 (B) THE INSTITUTE OF SCRAP RECYCLING INDUSTRIES, INC.
5 PUBLICATION "ELECTRONICS RECYCLING OPERATING PRACTICES", DATED
6 APRIL 25, 2006.

7 SEC. 17321. AFTER APRIL 1, 2012, THE DEPARTMENT, PURSUANT TO
8 THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES ACT OF 1969, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.201
9 TO 24.328, MAY PROMULGATE RULES FOR THE PURPOSES OF SECTIONS 17303
10 AND 17315.

11 SEC. 17333. IF FEDERAL LAW ESTABLISHES A NATIONAL PROGRAM FOR
12 THE COLLECTION AND RECYCLING OF COMPUTER EQUIPMENT, THE DEPARTMENT
13 SHALL, WITHIN 90 DAYS, SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE STANDING COMMITTEES
14 OF THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES WITH PRIMARY
15 RESPONSIBILITY FOR RECYCLING AND SOLID WASTE ISSUES. THE REPORT
16 SHALL DESCRIBE THE FEDERAL PROGRAM, DISCUSS WHETHER PROVISIONS OF
17 THIS PART HAVE BEEN PREEMPTED, AND RECOMMEND WHETHER THIS PART
18 SHOULD BE AMENDED OR REPEALED.

19 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
20 unless all of the following bills of the 94th Legislature are
21 enacted into law:
