SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 6025

A bill to establish the united way fund in the department of treasury; to establish the children's hospital of Michigan fund in the department of community health; to provide for the distribution of the money from those funds; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain agencies and officials; and to provide for appropriations.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 2 Sec. 1. This part shall be known and may be cited as the
- 3 "united way fund act".
- 4 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 5 (a) "Department" means the department of treasury.

- 1 (b) "Fund" means the united way fund created in section 3.
- 2 Sec. 3. (1) The united way fund is created in the department
- 3 to provide funds for donation to any united way of America
- 4 organization located in this state to improve lives by mobilizing
- 5 the caring power of communities to provide for basic needs,
- 6 including, but not limited to, food, clothing, and shelter.
- 7 (2) The state treasurer shall credit to the fund all amounts
- 8 appropriated for this purpose under section 435 of the income tax
- 9 act of 1967, 1967 PA 281, MCL 206.435.
- 10 (3) The fund shall consist of the money credited to the fund
- 11 pursuant to section 435 of the income tax act of 1967, 1967 PA 281,
- 12 MCL 206.435, any interest and earnings accruing from the saving and
- 13 investment of that money, and other appropriations, money, or other
- 14 things of value received by the fund.
- 15 (4) The state treasurer shall direct the investment of the
- **16** fund.
- Sec. 4. (1) The money, interest, and earnings of the fund
- 18 shall be expended solely for the purposes described in this act.
- 19 (2) Money granted or received as a gift or donation to the
- 20 fund is available for distribution upon appropriation to each
- 21 county from which a contribution, gift, or donation was received.
- Sec. 5. Money from the fund may be used as matching funds for
- 23 a federal grant if those funds are to be used for the purposes
- 24 described under section 3 only if the federal grant will benefit
- 25 the county from which the matching funds were received.
- 26 Sec. 6. The money in the fund that is available for
- 27 distribution shall be appropriated each year. Money in the fund at

- 2 to the general fund.

- 4 Sec. 11. This part shall be known and may be cited as the
- 5 "children's hospital of Michigan fund act".
- 6 Sec. 13. As used in this part:
- 7 (a) "Department" means the department of community health.
- 8 (b) "Fund" means the children's hospital of Michigan fund
- 9 created in section 15.
- 10 Sec. 15. (1) The children's hospital of Michigan fund is
- 11 created in the department to provide funds for donation to the
- 12 children's hospital of Michigan to support the children's hospital
- 13 of Michigan in providing life-saving pediatric care, education, and
- 14 research.
- 15 (2) The state treasurer shall credit to the fund all amounts
- 16 appropriated for this purpose under section 435 of the income tax
- 17 act of 1967, 1967 PA 281, MCL 206.435, and money from any other
- 18 source for deposit into the fund.
- 19 (3) The state treasurer shall direct the investment of the
- 20 fund. The fund shall consist of the money credited to the fund
- 21 pursuant to section 435 of the income tax act of 1967, 1967 PA 281,
- 22 MCL 206.435, any interest and earnings accruing from the saving and
- 23 investment of that money, and money from any other source.
- 24 (4) Money in the fund at the close of the year shall remain in
- 25 the fund and shall not lapse to the general fund.
- 26 Sec. 17. The money, interest, and earnings of the fund shall
- 27 be expended solely for donations to the children's hospital of

Michigan to support the children's hospital of Michigan in
providing life-saving pediatric care, education, and research.

Sec. 19. The money in the fund that is available for
distribution shall be appropriated each year. Money granted or
received as a gift or donation to the fund is available for
