SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 667

A bill to amend 1846 RS 83, entitled "Of marriage and the solemnization thereof," by amending section 7 (MCL 551.7), as amended by 2006 PA 613.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 7. (1) Marriages may be solemnized by any of the
- 2 following:
- 3 (a) A judge of the district court, in the district in which
- 4 the judge is serving.
- 5 (b) A district court magistrate, in the district in which the
- 6 magistrate serves.
- 7 (c) A municipal judge, in the city in which the judge is
- 8 serving or in a township over which a municipal court has
- 9 jurisdiction according to UNDER section 9928 of the revised
- 10 judicature act of 1961, 1961 PA 236, MCL 600.9928.

- 1 (d) A judge of probate, in the county or probate court
- 2 district in which the judge is serving.
- 3 (e) A judge of a federal court.
- 4 (f) A mayor of a city, anywhere in a county in which that city

- 7 serves, or —in ANOTHER COUNTY WITH THE WRITTEN AUTHORIZATION OF
- 8 THE CLERK OF THE OTHER COUNTY.

- 10 employee of the COUNTY clerk's office designated by the county
- 11 clerk[, in the county in which the clerk serves.]

- 21 (2) A person authorized by this act to solemnize a marriage
- 22 shall keep proper records and make returns as required by section 4

- 24 (3) If a mayor of a city solemnizes a marriage, the mayor
- 25 shall charge and collect a fee to be determined by the council of
- 26 that city, which shall be paid to the city treasurer and deposited
- in the general fund of the city at the end of the month.

- 1 (4) If the county clerk or, in a county having more than
- 2 2,000,000 inhabitants, an employee of the clerk's office designated
- 3 by the county clerk solemnizes a marriage, the county clerk shall
- 4 charge and collect a fee to be determined by the commissioners of
- 5 that THE county , IN which THE CLERK SERVES. THE FEE shall be paid
- 6 to the county treasurer FOR THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE CLERK SERVES
- 7 and deposited in the general fund of the THAT county at the end of
- 8 the month.
