

Senate Bill No. 1 as amended February 21, 2007

1 APPOINTMENTS, PARTICIPATION IN SMOKING CESSATION TREATMENT,
2 EXERCISE, PRENATAL VISITS, IMMUNIZATIONS, AND ATTENDANCE AT
3 RECOMMENDED EDUCATIONAL HEALTH PROGRAMS.

4 (2) THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY HEALTH SHALL CREATE PAY-FOR-
5 PERFORMANCE INCENTIVES FOR CONTRACTED MEDICAID HEALTH MAINTENANCE
6 ORGANIZATIONS. THE MEDICAID HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION
7 CONTRACTS SHALL INCLUDE INCENTIVES FOR MEETING HEALTH OUTCOME
8 TARGETS FOR CHRONIC DISEASE STATES, INCREASING THE NUMBER OF
9 MEDICAL ASSISTANCE RECIPIENTS WHO PRACTICE POSITIVE HEALTH
10 BEHAVIORS, AND MEETING PATIENT COMPLIANCE TARGETS ESTABLISHED BY
11 THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY HEALTH. PRIORITY SHALL BE GIVEN TO
12 STRATEGIES THAT PREVENT AND MANAGE THE 10 MOST PREVALENT AND COSTLY
13 AILMENTS AFFECTING MEDICAL ASSISTANCE RECIPIENTS.

14 (3) THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY HEALTH SHALL ESTABLISH A
15 PREFERRED PRODUCT AND SERVICE FORMULARY PROGRAM FOR DURABLE MEDICAL
16 EQUIPMENT. THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY HEALTH SHALL WORK WITH THE
17 CENTERS FOR MEDICARE AND MEDICAID SERVICES TO DETERMINE IF A JOINT
18 PARTNERSHIP WITH MEDICARE IS POSSIBLE IN ESTABLISHING THE PROGRAM
19 DESCRIBED IN THIS SUBSECTION AS A MEANS OF ACHIEVING SAVINGS AND
20 EFFICIENCIES FOR BOTH THE MEDICAID AND MEDICARE PROGRAMS. THE
21 PREFERRED PRODUCT AND SERVICE FORMULARY PROGRAM FOR DURABLE MEDICAL
22 EQUIPMENT SHALL REQUIRE PARTICIPATION FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF
23 COMMUNITY HEALTH<< AND SHALL PERMIT>> THE CONTRACTED MEDICAID HEALTH
24 MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATIONS<< AND PROVIDER ORGANIZATIONS TO PARTICIPATE.>>

25 (4) THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY HEALTH SHALL SEEK FINANCIAL
26 SUPPORT FOR ELECTRONIC HEALTH RECORDS, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED
27 TO, PERSONAL HEALTH RECORDS, E-PRESCRIBING, WEB-BASED MEDICAL

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1 RECORDS, AND OTHER HEALTH INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY INITIATIVES USING
2 MEDICAID FUNDS.

3 (5) THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY HEALTH SHALL INCLUDE IN ANY
4 FEDERAL WAIVER REQUEST THAT IS SUBMITTED WITH THE INTENT TO SECURE
5 FEDERAL MATCHING FUNDS TO COVER THE MEDICALLY UNINSURED NONMEDICAID
6 POPULATION IN THE STATE LANGUAGE TO ALLOW THE DEPARTMENT OF
7 COMMUNITY HEALTH TO ESTABLISH, AT A MINIMUM, THE PROGRAMS REQUIRED
8 UNDER SUBSECTIONS (1) AND (2).
