## SUBSTITUTE FOR

## SENATE BILL NO. 16

A bill to establish the prostate cancer research fund in the department of community health; to provide for the distribution of money from the fund; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain agencies and officials; and to provide for appropriations.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 2 "prostate cancer research fund act".
- 3 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 4 (a) "Department" means the department of community health.
- 5 (b) "Fund" means the prostate cancer research fund created in
- 6 section 3.
- 7 Sec. 3. (1) The prostate cancer research fund is created in
- 8 the department to provide funds to promote research in this state

- 1 relating to prostate cancer.
- 2 (2) The state treasurer shall credit to the fund all amounts
- 3 appropriated for this purpose under section 435 of the income tax
- 4 act of 1967, 1967 PA 281, MCL 206.435.
- 5 (3) The fund shall consist of the money credited to the fund
- 6 pursuant to section 435 of the income tax act of 1967, 1967 PA 281,
- 7 MCL 206.435, any interest and earnings accruing from the saving and
- 8 investment of that money, and other appropriations, money, or other
- 9 things of value received by the fund.
- 10 (4) The state treasurer shall direct the investment of the
- **11** fund.
- 12 (5) Money in the fund at the close of the year shall remain in
- 13 the fund and shall not lapse to the general fund.
- 14 Sec. 4. (1) The money, interest, and earnings of the fund
- 15 shall be expended solely for grants to any of the following:
- 16 (a) A medical school located in this state.
- 17 (b) A hospital located in this state that specializes in the
- 18 treatment of cancer.
- 19 (c) A hospital located in an urban area in this state that
- 20 provides services to African-American men. As used in this
- 21 subdivision, "urban area" means an urbanized area as determined by
- 22 the economics and statistics administration of the United States
- 23 bureau of the census according to the 2000 federal decennial
- 24 census.
- 25 (2) Money granted or received as a gift or donation to the
- 26 fund is available for distribution upon appropriation.
- 27 Sec. 5. Money from the fund may be used as matching funds for

- 1 a federal grant or a grant from the national cancer institute.
- 2 Sec. 6. The money in the fund that is available for
- 3 distribution shall be appropriated each year.
- 4 Enacting section 1. This act does not take effect unless
- 5 Senate Bill No. 347 of the 94th Legislature is enacted into law.
