## SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 115

A bill to amend 2003 PA 226, entitled "Joint municipal planning act," by amending the title and sections 5 and 7 (MCL 125.135 and 125.137).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 TITLE 2 An act to provide for joint land use planning and the joint 3 exercise of certain zoning powers and duties ZONING by local units 4 of government; and to provide for the establishment, powers, and 5 duties of joint planning commissions and zoning boards of appeals. 6 Sec. 5. (1) Subject to section 9, the legislative bodies of 2 7 or more municipalities may each adopt an ordinance approving an agreement establishing a joint planning commission. The agreement 8 9 shall specify at least all of the following:

- 1 (a) The composition of the joint planning commission,
- 2 including any alternate members.
- 3 (b) The qualifications, the selection by election or
- 4 appointment, and the terms of office of members of the joint
- 5 planning commission.
- 6 (c) Conditions and procedures for removal from office of
- 7 members of the joint planning commission and for filling vacancies
- 8 in the joint planning commission.
- 9 (d) How the operating budget of the joint planning commission
- 10 will be shared by the participating municipalities.
- 11 (e) The jurisdictional area of the joint planning commission,
- 12 which may consist of all or part of the combined territory of the
- 13 participating municipalities.
- 14 (f) Procedures by which a municipality may join or withdraw
- 15 from the joint planning commission.
- 16 (g) The planning act whose procedure will be followed by the
- 17 joint planning commission in adopting a plan or exercising any
- 18 other power or performing any other duty of a planning commission.
- 19 The planning act shall be a planning act that would otherwise be
- 20 applicable to at least 1 participating municipality.
- 21 (h) The zoning act whose procedure will be followed by the
- 22 joint planning commission in exercising the powers and performing
- 23 the duties of a zoning board or zoning commission. The zoning act
- 24 shall be a zoning act that would otherwise be applicable to at
- 25 least 1 participating municipality.
- 26 (H) FOR SITUATIONS IN WHICH THE PROCEDURES UNDER THE MICHIGAN
- 27 ZONING ENABLING ACT, 2006 PA 110, MCL 125.3101 TO 125.3702,

- 1 APPLICABLE TO A PLANNING COMMISSION DEPEND ON WHETHER THE RELEVANT
- 2 MUNICIPALITY IS A TOWNSHIP OR IS A CITY OR VILLAGE, A DESIGNATION
- 3 EITHER THAT THE PROCEDURES APPLICABLE TO A TOWNSHIP WILL BE
- 4 FOLLOWED BY THE JOINT PLANNING COMMISSION OR THAT THE PROCEDURES
- 5 APPLICABLE TO A CITY OR VILLAGE WILL BE FOLLOWED BY THE JOINT
- 6 PLANNING COMMISSION. PROCEDURES APPLICABLE TO A TOWNSHIP SHALL NOT
- 7 BE DESIGNATED UNLESS AT LEAST 1 OF THE PARTICIPATING MUNICIPALITIES
- 8 IS A TOWNSHIP. PROCEDURES APPLICABLE TO A CITY OR VILLAGE SHALL NOT
- 9 BE DESIGNATED UNLESS AT LEAST 1 OF THE PARTICIPATING MUNICIPALITIES
- 10 IS A CITY OR VILLAGE.
- 11 (i) Any additional provision concerning the powers or duties
- 12 of a zoning board or zoning commission that the zoning act
- 13 specified pursuant to subdivision (h) MICHIGAN ZONING ENABLING ACT,
- 14 2006 PA 110, MCL 125.3101 TO 125.3702, authorizes to be set forth
- 15 in a zoning ordinance and that is agreed to by the participating
- 16 municipalities.
- 17 (J) THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE AGREEMENT.
- 18 (2) THE AGREEMENT MAY PROVIDE FOR THE PHASED TRANSFER TO THE
- 19 JOINT PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF EXISTING
- 20 PLANNING COMMISSIONS OR ZONING BOARDS OR ZONING COMMISSIONS UNDER
- 21 SECTION 7.
- 22 Sec. 7. (1) All—SUBJECT TO SECTION 5(2), ALL the powers and
- 23 duties of a planning commission under each planning act are, with
- 24 respect to the jurisdictional area of the joint planning
- 25 commission, transferred to the joint planning commission. In
- 26 exercising such powers or performing such duties, the joint
- 27 planning commission shall follow the procedure provided under the

- 1 planning act specified pursuant to section 5(g).
- 2 (2) All SUBJECT TO SECTION 5(2), ALL the powers and duties of
- 3 a zoning board or zoning commission under each zoning act THE
- 4 MICHIGAN ZONING ENABLING ACT, 2006 PA 110, MCL 125.3101 TO
- 5 125.3702, are, with respect to the jurisdictional area of the joint
- 6 planning commission, transferred to the joint planning commission.
- 7 In exercising such powers or performing such duties, the joint
- 8 planning commission shall follow the procedure provided under the
- 9 zoning act specified pursuant to section 5(h), WHEN RELEVANT.
- 10 (3) If only part of the territory of a participating
- 11 municipality is in the jurisdictional area of a joint planning
- 12 commission, the participating municipality, with the joint planning
- 13 commission acting as the zoning board or zoning commission, may
- 14 adopt a zoning ordinance that affects only that portion of its
- 15 territory in the jurisdictional area of the joint planning
- 16 commission.
- 17 (4) THE PARTICIPATING MUNICIPALITIES, WITH THE JOINT PLANNING
- 18 COMMISSION ACTING AS THE ZONING COMMISSION, MAY EACH ADOPT A JOINT
- 19 ZONING ORDINANCE THAT AFFECTS THE JURISDICTIONAL AREA OF THE JOINT
- 20 PLANNING COMMISSION AND PROVIDES FOR THE JOINT ADMINISTRATION OF
- 21 THE JOINT ZONING ORDINANCE, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, A JOINT
- 22 ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS.
