SUBSTITUTE FOR

SENATE BILL NO. 348

A bill to establish the Amanda's fund for breast cancer research in the department of community health; to provide for the distribution of money from the fund; to prescribe the duties and powers of certain agencies and officials; and to provide for appropriations.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 2 "Amanda's fund for breast cancer research act".
- 3 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 4 (a) "Department" means the department of community health.
- 5 (b) "Fund" means the Amanda's fund for breast cancer research
- 6 created in section 3.
- 7 Sec. 3. (1) The Amanda's fund for breast cancer research is

- 1 created in the department to provide funds to promote research in
- 2 this state relating to breast cancer.
- 3 (2) The state treasurer shall credit to the fund all amounts
- 4 appropriated for this purpose under section 435 of the income tax
- 5 act of 1967, 1967 PA 281, MCL 206.435.
- 6 (3) The fund shall consist of the money credited to the fund
- 7 pursuant to section 435 of the income tax act of 1967, 1967 PA 281,
- 8 MCL 206.435, any interest and earnings accruing from the saving and
- 9 investment of that money, and other appropriations, money, or other
- 10 things of value received by the fund.
- 11 (4) The state treasurer shall direct the investment of the
- **12** fund.
- 13 (5) Money in the fund at the close of the year shall remain in
- 14 the fund and shall not lapse to the general fund.
- Sec. 4. (1) The money, interest, and earnings of the fund
- 16 shall be expended solely for the purposes described in this act.
- 17 (2) Money granted or received as a gift or donation to the
- 18 fund is available for distribution upon appropriation.
- 19 Sec. 5. The department shall do all of the following with the
- 20 money from the fund:
- (a) Support the development of a statewide breast cancer
- 22 research plan.
- 23 (b) Provide information to the public about the value of
- 24 breast cancer research and early detection.
- 25 (c) Develop and publicize criteria for proposals to be funded
- 26 under this act.
- (d) Review and approve proposals to be funded under this act.

- 1 Sec. 6. (1) The department shall determine which proposals to
- 2 fund with money from the fund. The department shall solicit
- 3 proposals and approve proposals for funding under this act.
- 4 Proposals may be submitted only by individuals, groups, and
- 5 institutions with an interest in breast cancer research activities.
- 6 (2) The department shall review and approve proposals
- 7 submitted for funding under this act and shall give priority to
- 8 proposals submitted by applicants that are located in this state
- 9 and that conduct the research or other activity that is the basis
- 10 for the proposal in this state. The money in the fund shall be used
- 11 to fund, but is not limited to funding, the following types of
- 12 programs:
- 13 (a) Proposals for applied breast cancer research.
- 14 (b) Community education programs to raise awareness through
- 15 county, city, or township programs.
- Sec. 7. Money from the fund may be used as matching funds for
- 17 a federal grant or a grant from the national cancer institute.
- 18 Sec. 8. The money in the fund that is available for
- 19 distribution shall be appropriated each year. If money remains in
- 20 the fund at the close of the state fiscal year, that money shall
- 21 remain in the fund and shall not lapse to the general fund.
- 22 Enacting section 1. This act does not take effect unless
- 23 Senate Bill No. 347 of the 94th Legislature is enacted into law.
