SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 549

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code," (MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1284a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 1284A. (1) NOT LATER THAN JULY 1, 2008, AN INTERMEDIATE
- 2 SCHOOL DISTRICT, IN COOPERATION WITH ITS CONSTITUENT DISTRICTS,
- 3 SHALL ADOPT A COMMON SCHOOL CALENDAR TO APPLY TO ALL OF ITS
- 4 CONSTITUENT DISTRICTS AND TO ITS INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT
- 5 PROGRAMS. THE INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL POST THE COMMON
- 6 SCHOOL CALENDAR ON ITS WEBSITE. THE COMMON SCHOOL CALENDAR SHALL
- 7 MEET ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 8 (A) SHALL BE IN COMPLIANCE WITH SECTIONS 1284 AND 1284B.
- 9 (B) SHALL IDENTIFY THE DATES FOR EACH SCHOOL YEAR WHEN SCHOOL
- 10 WILL NOT BE IN SESSION FOR AT LEAST A WINTER HOLIDAY BREAK, A

- 1 SPRING BREAK, AND PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT DAYS. THE COMMON SCHOOL
- 2 CALENDAR SHALL IDENTIFY THESE DATES SPECIFICALLY FOR AT LEAST THE
- 3 NEXT 5 SCHOOL YEARS, BUT MAY DESCRIBE THESE DATES MORE GENERALLY
- 4 FOR SCHOOL YEARS THEREAFTER AS LONG AS THE DATES MAY BE READILY
- 5 DETERMINED.
- 6 (2) BEGINNING WITH THE 2008-2009 SCHOOL YEAR, EXCEPT AS
- 7 OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, THE BOARD OF EACH CONSTITUENT
- 8 DISTRICT AND THE INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL BOARD SHALL ENSURE THAT ITS
- 9 SCHOOL CALENDAR COMPLIES WITH THE COMMON SCHOOL CALENDAR ADOPTED
- 10 UNDER SUBSECTION (1).
- 11 (3) IF A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT THAT PROVIDES A
- 12 COMPLETE SCHOOL CALENDAR IS IN EFFECT FOR EMPLOYEES OF A SCHOOL
- 13 DISTRICT OR INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT AS OF THE EFFECTIVE DATE
- 14 OF THIS SECTION, AND IF THAT SCHOOL CALENDAR IS NOT IN COMPLIANCE
- 15 WITH THE COMMON SCHOOL CALENDAR ADOPTED UNDER SUBSECTION (1), THEN
- 16 SUBSECTION (2) DOES NOT APPLY TO THAT SCHOOL DISTRICT OR
- 17 INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT UNTIL AFTER THE EXPIRATION OF THAT
- 18 COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT.
- 19 (4) IF AS OF THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION AN
- 20 INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT OR SCHOOL DISTRICT IS OPERATING A
- 21 YEAR-ROUND SCHOOL OR PROGRAM OR IS OPERATING A SCHOOL THAT IS AN
- 22 INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE ACADEMY THAT PROVIDES 1,160 HOURS OF
- 23 PUPIL INSTRUCTION PER SCHOOL YEAR, THEN SUBSECTION (2) DOES NOT
- 24 APPLY TO THAT SCHOOL OR PROGRAM. IF AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF
- 25 THIS SECTION AN INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT OR SCHOOL DISTRICT
- 26 BEGINS OPERATING A YEAR-ROUND SCHOOL OR PROGRAM, THE SCHOOL
- 27 DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY

- 1 MAY APPLY TO THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION FOR A WAIVER
- 2 FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (2) FOR THAT SCHOOL OR PROGRAM.
- 3 THE APPLICATION SHALL BE IN WRITING IN THE FORM AND MANNER
- 4 PRESCRIBED BY THE DEPARTMENT AND SHALL PROVIDE JUSTIFICATION FOR
- 5 THE SCHOOL OR PROGRAM TO OPERATE ON A CALENDAR THAT DIFFERS FROM
- 6 THE COMMON CALENDAR ADOPTED UNDER SUBSECTION (1). UPON APPLICATION,
- 7 IF THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION DETERMINES THAT A
- 8 SCHOOL OR PROGRAM IS A BONA FIDE YEAR-ROUND SCHOOL OR PROGRAM
- 9 ESTABLISHED FOR EDUCATIONAL REASONS AND THAT THERE IS SUFFICIENT
- 10 JUSTIFICATION FOR THE SCHOOL OR PROGRAM TO OPERATE ON A CALENDAR
- 11 THAT DIFFERS FROM THE COMMON CALENDAR ADOPTED UNDER SUBSECTION (1),
- 12 THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION SHALL GRANT THE WAIVER.
- 13 THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION SHALL ESTABLISH STANDARDS
- 14 FOR DETERMINING A BONA FIDE YEAR-ROUND SCHOOL OR PROGRAM FOR THE
- 15 PURPOSES OF THIS SUBSECTION.
- 16 (5) IF AN INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT OR SCHOOL DISTRICT IS
- 17 OPERATING OR BEGINS OPERATING A SCHOOL OR PROGRAM ON A TRIMESTER
- 18 SCHEDULE, THE SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR
- 19 PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY MAY APPLY TO THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC
- 20 INSTRUCTION FOR A WAIVER FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (2)
- 21 FOR THAT SCHOOL OR PROGRAM. THE APPLICATION SHALL BE IN WRITING IN
- 22 THE FORM AND MANNER PRESCRIBED BY THE DEPARTMENT AND SHALL PROVIDE
- 23 JUSTIFICATION FOR THE SCHOOL OR PROGRAM TO OPERATE ON A CALENDAR
- 24 THAT DIFFERS FROM THE COMMON CALENDAR ADOPTED UNDER SUBSECTION (1).
- 25 UPON APPLICATION, IF THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION
- 26 DETERMINES THAT A SCHOOL OR PROGRAM IS OPERATING ON A BONA FIDE
- 27 TRIMESTER SCHEDULE ESTABLISHED FOR EDUCATIONAL REASONS AND THAT

- 1 THERE IS SUFFICIENT JUSTIFICATION FOR THE SCHOOL OR PROGRAM TO
- OPERATE ON A CALENDAR THAT DIFFERS FROM THE COMMON CALENDAR ADOPTED 2
- 3 UNDER SUBSECTION (1), THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION
- SHALL GRANT THE WAIVER. THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION 4
- SHALL ESTABLISH STANDARDS FOR DETERMINING A BONA FIDE TRIMESTER 5
- SCHEDULE FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SUBSECTION. 6
- 7 (6) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A PUBLIC SCHOOL THAT
- OPERATES ALL OF GRADES 6 TO 12 AT A SINGLE SITE, THAT ALIGNS ITS 8
- 9 HIGH SCHOOL CURRICULUM WITH ADVANCED PLACEMENT COURSES AS THE
- 10 CAPSTONE OF THE CURRICULUM, AND THAT ENDS ITS SECOND ACADEMIC
- 11 SEMESTER CONCURRENTLY WITH THE END OF THE ADVANCED PLACEMENT
- 12 EXAMINATION PERIOD.
