SUBSTITUTE FOR

SENATE BILL NO. 1066

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

(MCL 257.1 to 257.923) by adding sections 3a and 320d.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 3A. "BASIC DRIVER IMPROVEMENT COURSE" MEANS A COURSE OF
- 2 STUDY THAT SATISFIES ALL OF THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:
- 3 (A) IT MEETS OR EXCEEDS THE CURRICULUM STANDARDS SET FORTH IN
- 4 THE DEFENSIVE DRIVING COURSE INSTRUCTOR MANUAL, EIGHTH EDITION,
- 5 PUBLISHED BY THE NATIONAL SAFETY COUNCIL.
- 6 (B) IT PROVIDES DOCUMENTED EVIDENCE FROM A FEDERAL, STATE, OR
- 7 LOCAL AGENCY OF COURSE EFFECTIVENESS IN REDUCING COLLISIONS, MOVING
- 8 VIOLATIONS, OR BOTH.
- 9 (C) IT CONTAINS SUCH OTHER INFORMATION AS IS APPROVED BY THE
- 10 SECRETARY OF STATE AND THAT IS OFFERED OVER THE INTERNET OR THROUGH
- 11 CLASSROOM INSTRUCTION.

- 1 SEC. 320D. (1) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL NOT ENTER THE
- 2 POINTS CORRESPONDING TO A MOVING VIOLATION COMMITTED BY AN
- 3 INDIVIDUAL THE SECRETARY OF STATE DETERMINES TO BE ELIGIBLE UNDER
- 4 THIS SECTION ON THE INDIVIDUAL'S DRIVING RECORD OR MAKE INFORMATION
- 5 CONCERNING THAT VIOLATION AVAILABLE TO ANY INSURANCE COMPANY IF THE
- 6 INDIVIDUAL ATTENDS AND SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETES A BASIC DRIVER
- 7 IMPROVEMENT COURSE UNDER THIS SECTION AND PROVIDES A CERTIFICATE OF
- 8 SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF THAT COURSE TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE
- 9 WITHIN 60 DAYS OF THE DATE ON WHICH THE SECRETARY OF STATE NOTIFIED
- 10 THE INDIVIDUAL THAT HE OR SHE WAS ELIGIBLE TO TAKE A BASIC DRIVER
- 11 IMPROVEMENT COURSE.
- 12 (2) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL DETERMINE IF AN INDIVIDUAL IS
- 13 ELIGIBLE UNDER SUBSECTION (3) TO ATTEND A BASIC DRIVER IMPROVEMENT
- 14 COURSE UPON RECEIPT OF AN ABSTRACT OF A MOVING VIOLATION. IF THE
- 15 SECRETARY OF STATE DETERMINES THAT AN INDIVIDUAL IS ELIGIBLE TO
- 16 ATTEND A BASIC DRIVER IMPROVEMENT COURSE, THE SECRETARY OF STATE
- 17 SHALL DO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 18 (A) POSTPONE THE ENTRY OF POINTS FOR THE MOVING VIOLATION
- 19 UNDER SECTION 320A OR MAKE INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THE ABSTRACT
- 20 AVAILABLE TO THE INDIVIDUAL'S INSURANCE COMPANY FOR A PERIOD OF NOT
- 21 LESS THAN 10 BUSINESS DAYS, EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED UNDER
- 22 SUBSECTION (8).
- 23 (B) NOTIFY THE INDIVIDUAL OF HIS OR HER ELIGIBILITY BY FIRST-
- 24 CLASS MAIL AT THE INDIVIDUAL'S LAST KNOWN ADDRESS AS INDICATED ON
- 25 THE INDIVIDUAL'S OPERATOR'S OR CHAUFFEUR'S LICENSE, AND INFORM THE
- 26 INDIVIDUAL OF THE LOCATION OF BASIC DRIVER IMPROVEMENT COURSES, AND
- 27 INFORM THE INDIVIDUAL OF THE MANNER AND TIME WITHIN WHICH THE

- 1 INDIVIDUAL IS REQUIRED TO NOTIFY THE SECRETARY OF STATE OF THE
- 2 INDIVIDUAL'S INTENT TO ATTEND A BASIC DRIVER IMPROVEMENT COURSE.
- 3 (C) NOTIFY THE INDIVIDUAL THAT IF THE INDIVIDUAL FAILS TO
- 4 NOTIFY THE SECRETARY OF STATE OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S INTENT TO ATTEND
- 5 A BASIC DRIVER IMPROVEMENT COURSE AS DESCRIBED UNDER SUBDIVISION
- 6 (B), POINTS WILL BE ENTERED FOR THE MOVING VIOLATION AS DESCRIBED
- 7 IN SUBSECTION (8).
- 8 (3) AN INDIVIDUAL IS ELIGIBLE TO TAKE A BASIC DRIVER
- 9 IMPROVEMENT COURSE IF ONLY NONE OF THE FOLLOWING APPLY:
- 10 (A) THE VIOLATION OCCURRED WHILE THE INDIVIDUAL WAS OPERATING
- 11 A COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE OR WAS LICENSED AS A COMMERCIAL DRIVER
- 12 WHILE OPERATING A NONCOMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE AT THE TIME OF THE
- 13 OFFENSE.
- 14 (B) THE VIOLATION IS A CRIMINAL OFFENSE.
- 15 (C) THE VIOLATION IS A VIOLATION FOR WHICH 4 OR MORE POINTS
- 16 MAY BE ASSESSED UNDER SECTION 320A.
- 17 (D) THE VIOLATION IS A VIOLATION OF SECTION 626B, 627(9),
- 18 627A, OR 682.
- 19 (E) THE INDIVIDUAL PREVIOUSLY SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED A BASIC
- 20 DRIVER IMPROVEMENT COURSE.
- 21 (F) THE INDIVIDUAL HAS 3 OR MORE POINTS ON HIS OR HER DRIVING
- 22 RECORD.
- 23 (G) THE INDIVIDUAL'S OPERATOR'S OR CHAUFFEUR'S LICENSE IS
- 24 RESTRICTED, SUSPENDED, OR REVOKED, OR THE INDIVIDUAL WAS NOT ISSUED
- 25 AN OPERATOR'S OR CHAUFFEUR'S LICENSE.
- 26 (4) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL MAINTAIN A COMPUTERIZED
- 27 DATABASE OF THE FOLLOWING:

- 1 (A) INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE ATTENDED A BASIC DRIVER IMPROVEMENT
- 2 COURSE.
- 3 (B) INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED A BASIC DRIVER
- 4 IMPROVEMENT COURSE.
- 5 (5) THE DATABASE MAINTAINED UNDER SUBSECTION (4) SHALL ONLY BE
- 6 USED FOR DETERMINING ELIGIBILITY UNDER SUBSECTION (3). THE
- 7 SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL ONLY MAKE THE INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THE
- 8 DATABASE AVAILABLE TO APPROVED SPONSORS UNDER SUBSECTION (10).
- 9 INFORMATION IN THIS DATABASE CONCERNING AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL BE
- 10 MAINTAINED FOR THE LIFE OF THAT INDIVIDUAL.
- 11 (6) AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL BE CHARGED A FEE OF NOT MORE THAN
- 12 \$100.00 TO PARTICIPATE IN A BASIC DRIVER IMPROVEMENT COURSE AND, IF
- 13 APPLICABLE, TO OBTAIN A CERTIFICATE IN A FORM AS APPROVED BY THE
- 14 SECRETARY OF STATE DEMONSTRATING THAT HE OR SHE SUCCESSFULLY
- 15 COMPLETED THE COURSE.
- 16 (7) FEES COLLECTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE CREDITED TO
- 17 THE BASIC DRIVER IMPROVEMENT COURSE FUND CREATED UNDER SUBSECTION
- 18 (9).
- 19 (8) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL IMMEDIATELY ENTER THE POINTS
- 20 FOR THE MOVING VIOLATION ON THE INDIVIDUAL'S DRIVING RECORD AS
- 21 FOLLOWS:
- 22 (A) TEN BUSINESS DAYS AFTER AN INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED IN
- 23 SUBSECTION (2) FAILS TO NOTIFY THE SECRETARY OF STATE THAT HE OR
- 24 SHE DESIRES TO ATTEND A BASIC DRIVER IMPROVEMENT COURSE.
- 25 (B) SIXTY DAYS AFTER AN INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (2)
- 26 WHO HAS PROPERLY NOTIFIED THE SECRETARY OF STATE THAT HE OR SHE
- 27 DESIRES TO ATTEND A BASIC DRIVER IMPROVEMENT COURSE BUT HAS FAILED

- 1 TO SUBMIT A CERTIFICATE OF SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF A BASIC DRIVER
- 2 IMPROVEMENT COURSE.
- 3 (9) THE BASIC DRIVER IMPROVEMENT COURSE FUND IS CREATED WITHIN
- 4 THE STATE TREASURY. THE STATE TREASURER MAY RECEIVE MONEY OR OTHER
- 5 ASSETS FROM ANY SOURCE FOR DEPOSIT INTO THE FUND. THE STATE
- 6 TREASURER SHALL DIRECT THE INVESTMENT OF THE FUND. MONEY IN THE
- 7 FUND AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR SHALL REMAIN IN THE FUND AND
- 8 SHALL NOT LAPSE TO THE GENERAL FUND. THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL
- 9 BE THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE FUND FOR AUDITING PURPOSES. THE
- 10 SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL EXPEND MONEY FROM THE FUND, UPON
- 11 APPROPRIATION, ONLY TO PAY THE COSTS OF ADMINISTERING THIS SECTION.
- 12 (10) AN APPROVED SPONSOR SHALL CONDUCT A STUDY OF THE EFFECT,
- 13 IF ANY, THAT THE SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF ITS BASIC DRIVER
- 14 IMPROVEMENT COURSE HAS ON REDUCING COLLISIONS, MOVING VIOLATIONS,
- 15 OR BOTH FOR STUDENTS COMPLETING ITS COURSE IN THIS STATE. AN
- 16 APPROVED SPONSOR SHALL CONDUCT THIS STUDY EVERY 5 YEARS ON EACH OF
- 17 THE COURSE DELIVERY MODALITIES EMPLOYED BY THE APPROVED SPONSOR.
- 18 THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL MAKE ALL OF THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION
- 19 AVAILABLE TO THE APPROVED COURSE SPONSOR FOR THAT PURPOSE, SUBJECT
- 20 TO APPLICABLE STATE AND FEDERAL LAWS GOVERNING THE RELEASE OF
- 21 INFORMATION:
- 22 (A) THE NUMBER OF INDIVIDUALS WHO SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETE A
- 23 BASIC DRIVER IMPROVEMENT COURSE UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 24 (B) THE NUMBER OF INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE ELIGIBLE TO TAKE A BASIC
- 25 DRIVER IMPROVEMENT COURSE UNDER THIS SECTION BUT WHO DO NOT
- 26 SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETE THAT COURSE.
- 27 (C) THE NUMBER AND TYPE OF MOVING VIOLATIONS COMMITTED BY

- 1 INDIVIDUALS AFTER SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETING A BASIC DRIVER
- 2 IMPROVEMENT COURSE UNDER THIS SECTION IN COMPARISON TO THE NUMBER
- 3 AND TYPE OF MOVING VIOLATIONS COMMITTED BY INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE NOT
- 4 TAKEN A BASIC DRIVER IMPROVEMENT COURSE.
- 5 (11) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL REPORT ON THE FINDINGS OF
- 6 ALL STUDIES CONDUCTED UNDER SUBSECTION (10) TO THE STANDING
- 7 COMMITTEES OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND SENATE ON
- 8 TRANSPORTATION ISSUES.
- 9 (12) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL APPROVE BASIC DRIVER
- 10 IMPROVEMENT COURSE SPONSORS IF THE BASIC DRIVER IMPROVEMENT COURSE
- 11 OFFERED BY THAT SPONSOR SATISFIES THE REQUIREMENTS LISTED IN
- 12 SECTION 3A.
- 13 (13) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "APPROVED SPONSOR" MEANS A
- 14 SPONSOR OF A BASIC DRIVER IMPROVEMENT COURSE THAT IS APPROVED BY
- 15 THE SECRETARY OF STATE UNDER SUBSECTION (12).
- 16 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect January
- **17** 1, 2009.
