## **HOUSE BILL No. 4017**

January 22, 2007, Introduced by Rep. Opsommer and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled

"Michigan vehicle code,"

(MCL 257.1 to 257.923) by adding section 653b.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 653B. (1) UPON APPROACHING AND PASSING A STATIONARY SOLID
- 2 WASTE COLLECTION VEHICLE, A UTILITY SERVICE VEHICLE, OR A ROAD
- 3 MAINTENANCE VEHICLE THAT IS GIVING A VISUAL SIGNAL BY MEANS OF
- 4 FLASHING, ROTATING, OR OSCILLATING AMBER LIGHTS AS PERMITTED BY
- 5 SECTION 698, THE DRIVER OF AN APPROACHING VEHICLE SHALL EXHIBIT DUE
- 6 CARE AND CAUTION, AS REQUIRED UNDER THE FOLLOWING:
- 7 (A) ON ANY PUBLIC ROADWAY WITH AT LEAST 2 ADJACENT LANES
- PROCEEDING IN THE SAME DIRECTION OF THE STATIONARY SOLID WASTE
  - COLLECTION VEHICLE, THE UTILITY SERVICE VEHICLE, OR THE ROAD

- 1 MAINTENANCE VEHICLE, THE DRIVER OF THE APPROACHING VEHICLE SHALL
- 2 PROCEED WITH CAUTION AND YIELD THE RIGHT-OF-WAY BY MOVING INTO A
- 3 LANE AT LEAST 1 MOVING LANE OR 2 VEHICLE WIDTHS APART FROM THE

- 11 ADJACENT LANES PROCEEDING IN THE SAME DIRECTION AS THE STATIONARY
- 12 SOLID WASTE COLLECTION VEHICLE, THE UTILITY SERVICE VEHICLE, OR THE
- 13 ROAD MAINTENANCE VEHICLE, OR IF THE MOVEMENT BY THE DRIVER OF THE

- 21 A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$500.00 OR IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN
- 22 90 DAYS, OR BOTH.
- 23 (3) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION AND CAUSES INJURY TO AN
- 24 EMPLOYEE OF THE SOLID WASTE HAULER, THE UTILITY PROVIDER, OR THE
- 25 ROAD MAINTENANCE AUTHORITY IN THE IMMEDIATE AREA OF THE STATIONARY
- 26 SOLID WASTE COLLECTION VEHICLE IS GUILTY OF A FELONY PUNISHABLE BY
- 27 A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,000.00 OR IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN

- 12 (B) "SOLID WASTE COLLECTION VEHICLE" MEANS A SOLID WASTE
- 13 TRANSPORTING UNIT THAT IS USED FOR THE CURBSIDE COLLECTION OF
- 14 MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE.
- 15 (C) "SOLID WASTE HAULER" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION
- 16 11506 OF THE NATURAL RESOURCES AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT,
- 17 1994 PA 451, MCL 324.11506.
- 18 (D) "SOLID WASTE TRANSPORTING UNIT" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED
- 19 IN SECTION 11506 OF THE NATURAL RESOURCES AND ENVIRONMENTAL
- 20 PROTECTION ACT, 1994 PA 451, MCL 324.11506.
- 21 (E) "UTILITY PROVIDER" MEANS AN ENTITY THAT DOES ANY OF THE
- 22 FOLLOWING AND THAT IS REGULATED AS A UTILITY UNDER THE LAWS OF THIS
- 23 STATE OR OF THE UNITED STATES:
- 24 (i) GENERATES OR DISTRIBUTES ELECTRICAL POWER TO THE PUBLIC.
- 25 (ii) GENERATES OR DISTRIBUTES NATURAL GAS TO THE PUBLIC.
- 26 (iii) PROVIDES SEWAGE COLLECTION SERVICES TO THE PUBLIC.
- 27 (iv) PROVIDES WATER DISTRIBUTION SERVICES TO THE PUBLIC.

- 1 (v) PROVIDES TELEPHONE SERVICES TO THE PUBLIC.

- 3 (F) "UTILITY SERVICE VEHICLE" MEANS A VEHICLE OWNED OR
- 4 OPERATED BY A UTILITY PROVIDER.

- 6 (i) THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.

- 8 (iii) AN ENTITY OPERATING UNDER CONTRACT WITH THE STATE
- 9 DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION OR A LOCAL AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE ROAD
- 10 CONSTRUCTION OR ROAD MAINTENANCE SERVICES.
- 11 (H) "ROAD MAINTENANCE VEHICLE" MEANS A VEHICLE OWNED OR
- 12 OPERATED BY A ROAD MAINTENANCE AUTHORITY.
