THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 491. (1) All official books, papers, or records created
- 2 by or received in any office or agency of the state of Michigan or
- 3 its political subdivisions, INCLUDING ANY BOOKS, PAPERS, OR RECORDS
- 4 CREATED, GENERATED, SENT, COMMUNICATED, RECEIVED, OR STORED BY
- 5 ELECTRONIC MEANS, are declared to be public property, belonging AND
- 6 BELONG to the people of the state of Michigan. All books, papers,
- 7 or records shall be disposed of only as provided in section 13c of
- 8 Act No. 51 of the Public Acts of the First Extra Session of 1948,
- as added, being section 18.13c of the Compiled Laws of 1948,

- 15 offices and shall refuse STATE AND REFUSES to deliver up such THOSE
- 16 books, papers, records, or parts thereof OF THE SAME to the proper
- 17 REQUESTING officer having charge of the office to which such THOSE
- 18 books, papers, or records belong, upon demand being made by such
- 19 officer or, in cases of a defunct office, the Michigan historical
- 20 commission, shall be IS guilty of a misdemeanor , punishable by
- 21 imprisonment in the state prison FOR not more than 2 years or by a
- 22 fine of not more than \$1,000.00.
