

HOUSE BILL No. 4218

February 7, 2007, Introduced by Reps. Robert Jones, LeBlanc, Vagnozzi, Young, Kathleen Law, Clack, Coulouris, Meadows and Hopgood and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled
"The revised school code,"
(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1164.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 1164. THE BOARD OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT OR BOARD OF
2 DIRECTORS OF A PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY SHALL ENSURE THAT, IF A COURSE
3 INCLUDES DISSECTION OF AN ANIMAL OR PART OF AN ANIMAL IN A
4 CLASSROOM AND A PUPIL EXPRESSES A MORAL OBJECTION TO THE
5 DISSECTION, THE TEACHER SHALL OFFER AN ALTERNATIVE ACTIVITY TO THE
6 DISSECTION.
