HOUSE BILL No. 4265

February 13, 2007, Introduced by Rep. Farrah and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1972 PA 382, entitled

"Traxler-McCauley-Law-Bowman bingo act,"

by amending section 5c (MCL 432.105c), as amended by 2006 PA 427.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 5c. (1) The value of a prize or consolation prize awarded
- 2 during a Michigan progressive jackpot bingo game is not subject to
- 3 the prize limitations of section 3a(3).
- 4 (2) The prize awarded to the winner of a Michigan progressive
- 5 jackpot bingo game may be a predetermined amount that shall not
- 6 exceed \$500.00 or 50% of the card sales on the first bingo
- 7 occasion.
 - (3) If a Michigan progressive jackpot prize is not won in the
 - predetermined number of allowable calls, the game shall be played

- 1 to its conclusion for a predetermined consolation prize that shall
- 2 not exceed \$100.00.
- 3 (4) If a Michigan progressive jackpot prize is not won in the
- 4 predetermined number of allowable calls, the entire prize amount
- 5 shall be carried forward to the next scheduled bingo occasion.
- 6 (5) When a Michigan progressive jackpot prize has been carried
- 7 forward from a previous bingo occasion, the new prize amount shall
- 8 include the entire amount carried forward, plus 50% of the card
- 9 sales for the Michigan progressive jackpot bingo game for the
- 10 current bingo occasion.
- 11 (6) No arrangement of numbers other than a coverall pattern
- 12 shall be required or allowed to win a Michigan progressive jackpot
- 13 bingo game.
- 14 (7) A Michigan progressive jackpot bingo game shall be played
- 15 only on bingo cards that are approved by the commissioner.
- 16 (8) All cards for the Michigan progressive jackpot bingo game
- 17 shall be sold by the licensee at a uniform price with no discount
- 18 for the purchase of more than 1 card.
- 19 (9) Whenever a Michigan progressive jackpot bingo game is
- 20 conducted, the licensee shall post a notice THAT CONTAINS, and
- 21 SHALL announce, the following information:
- 22 (a) The maximum number of allowable calls in which the player
- 23 must complete a coverall pattern in order to win a Michigan
- 24 progressive jackpot prize on that occasion.
- 25 (b) The prize amount offered to the winner of the Michigan
- 26 progressive jackpot game and the consolation prize for that bingo
- 27 occasion.

- 1 (c) The date the next bingo occasion will occur in that
- 2 particular progression if the jackpot is not awarded.
- 3 (10) A Michigan progressive jackpot bingo game shall be
- 4 conducted in the following manner:
- 5 (a) On the first bingo occasion a player shall not be required
- 6 to obtain bingo in less than the number of allowable calls as
- 7 prescribed by the commissioner to win the jackpot prize.
- 8 (b) The number of allowable calls required to win the jackpot
- 9 shall be increased by 1 number on each successive bingo occasion
- 10 for that licensee in a particular progression.
- 11 (c) Once a Michigan progressive jackpot bingo game has been
- 12 started, the progressive jackpot prize shall be offered at each
- 13 successive bingo occasion for that licensee until the jackpot prize
- 14 has been won.
- 15 (d) A Michigan progressive jackpot progression shall only be
- 16 terminated or interrupted by 1 of the following:
- 17 (i) Determining a winner of the Michigan progressive jackpot
- 18 prize.
- 19 (ii) Expiration, suspension, revocation, or surrender of the
- 20 license to conduct bingo.
- 21 (iii) A previously announced scheduled interruption, such as a
- 22 legal holiday or other temporary closing.
- 23 (iv) A valid emergency condition under which the licensee is
- 24 unable to conduct the game.
- 25 (11) Only 1 Michigan progressive jackpot bingo game shall be
- 26 in progress at 1 time per bingo occasion, EXCEPT THAT 2 MICHIGAN
- 27 PROGRESSIVE JACKPOT BINGO GAMES MAY BE IN PROGRESS AT 1 TIME AT A

- 1 BINGO OCCASION IF 1 OF THE GAMES IS LINKED TOGETHER WITH BINGO
- 2 GAMES CONDUCTED BY 1 OR MORE OTHER LICENSEES FOR THE PURPOSE OF A
- 3 COMMON JACKPOT PRIZE AND CONSOLATION PRIZE AS PRESCRIBED BY THE
- 4 COMMISSIONER.
- 5 (12) Prizes for a Michigan progressive jackpot bingo game
- 6 shall be awarded as follows:
- 7 (a) The Michigan progressive jackpot prize shall be awarded to
- 8 the player or players who complete the coverall pattern within the
- 9 predesignated number of allowable calls.
- 10 (b) A consolation prize shall be awarded on each bingo
- 11 occasion at which a Michigan progressive jackpot game is played,
- 12 except on the bingo occasion that the jackpot prize is won.
- 13 (c) The consolation prize shall be awarded to the player or
- 14 players who complete a coverall pattern on each bingo occasion,
- 15 regardless of the number of calls in excess of the predesignated
- 16 number of allowable calls required to win the Michigan progressive
- 17 jackpot bingo game.
- 18 (13) The jackpot prize shall be awarded by a check written
- 19 from the licensee's financial account or in the manner prescribed
- 20 by the commissioner.
- 21 (14) Except as otherwise provided in this section, all other
- 22 provisions of this act or rules promulgated under this act apply to
- 23 the conduct of a Michigan progressive jackpot game.
- 24 (15) If an organization's bingo license will expire or is
- 25 suspended, revoked, or surrendered before the last bingo occasion
- 26 of a particular progression, the jackpot prize shall be awarded and
- 27 the winner determined on the last authorized bingo occasion

1 regardless of the number of calls required to determine the winner.
