A bill to designate an official language of this state.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. (1) The English language is designated as the official
2 language of this state.

3 (2) Except as otherwise provided by law, a state agency is not
4 required to provide documents, publish written materials, or
5 provide website content in any language other than the official
6 language of this state.

7 (3) As used in this section, "state agency" means that term as
8 defined in section 115 of the management and budget act, 1984 PA
9 431, MCL 18.1115.
