HOUSE BILL No. 4621

April 19, 2007, Introduced by Reps. Espinoza, Rick Jones, Brown, Stahl, Clack, Hopgood, Polidori, Meadows, Kathleen Law and Johnson and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1945 PA 210, entitled

"An act to authorize county sheriffs to adopt rules and regulations for the conduct of prisoners in their custody; to provide for the keeping of certain records in connection with said prisoners; and to credit said prisoners with good behavior allowance for obeying said rules and regulations,"

by amending section 2 (MCL 51.282), as amended by 1986 PA 115.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 2. (1) The sheriff shall cause to be kept a record of
 each and all infractions of the rules and regulations by prisoners,
 with the names of the persons so offending and the date and
 character of each offense, and shall examine such THOSE records as
 often as may be necessary to carry out the purpose and intent of
 this act.
 - (2) Every prisoner whose record shows that there are no violations of the rules and regulations shall be IS entitled to a reduction from his or her sentence as follows: 1 day 2 DAYS for

- 1 each 6-7 days of the sentence.
- 2 (3) The sheriff may, by general rule, subject to amendment
- 3 from time to time, prescribe how much of the good time earned under
- 4 this subsection (2) a prisoner shall forfeit for any infraction of
- 5 the general rules and regulations. , and for FOR any act of
- 6 insubordination, the sheriff may, by special order, take away any
- 7 portion of or the whole of the good time made by any prisoner up to
- 8 the date of such THAT offense. The sheriff, may as a reward for
- 9 especially good conduct, in case of insubordination, MAY restore to
- 10 any prisoner the whole or any portion of the good time lost because
- 11 of any minor infraction of the rules.
