THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 556. (1) Any AN employer of labor in this state,

employing both males and females, who shall NOT discriminate in any
way in the payment of wages as between sexes who are similarly
employed., shall be

(2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS guilty of a misdemeanor PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 90 DAYS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$500.00, OR BOTH. No female shall be assigned any task disproportionate to her strength, nor shall she be employed in any place detrimental to her morals, her health or
